Update to Chlamydia Vital Signs population data:

Following requests from a number of PCTs the Department of Health has decided to change denominator data used to calculate the percent of the population tested. Population data are now based on figures provided by PCTs to the Department of Health and might not equal the mid-2006 ONS estimates used in previous VSI publications.

This update in denominator information came about because of a difference between data used by the HPA to calculate coverage in Q1 and Q2 and those submitted by PCTs as part of their plans against the Vital Signs indicator 2008/9 for chlamydia.

Notes on using these tables:

Chlamydia tests reported to the NCSP are based on young people aged between 15 and 24 years and includes tests where sex is male, female, and unknown/unspecified. Data as of 22.05.09 and may not reflect all screens/tests performed.

Data include all tests - screening tests, diagnostic tests and contacts and are presented by PCT of residence or "attributed" PCT of residence.

Data are number of tests and not number of people tested. Please note that number of tests as collected through the NCSP programme will be used a proxy for the number of people tested.

Data presented are based on tests with confirmed positive and negative results only. Tests with equivocal, inhibitory and insufficient results have been excluded as most people with these results are retested.

Please note that as of 1st April 2008 partners/contacts reported to the NCSP via the quarterly disaggregate dataset will count towards the Vital Signs indicator target. Be aware partners/contacts reported via the six monthly aggregate dataset will not count towards these figures.
