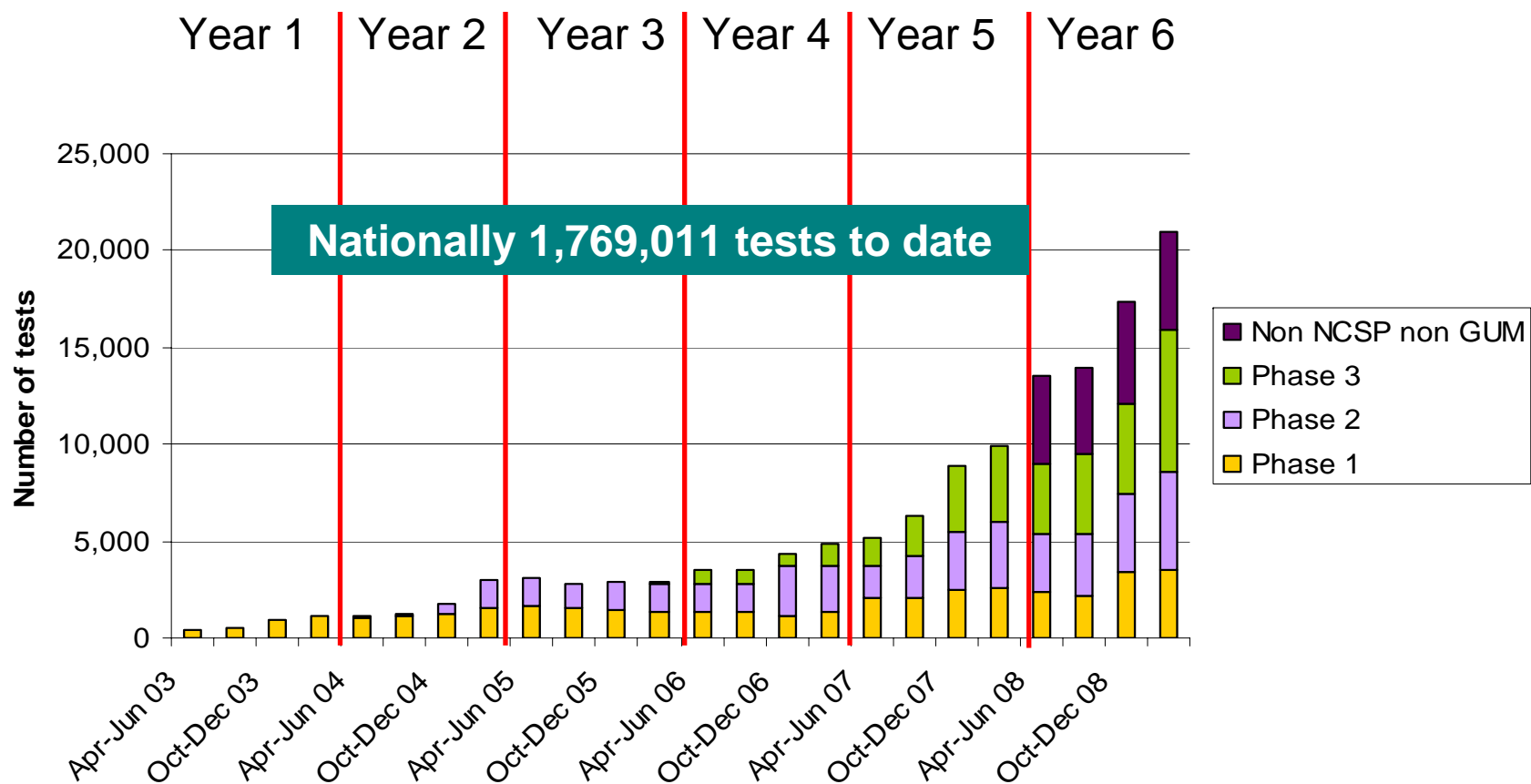

 - Modelling studies (35%) – 185,169 (2008/2009 PCT plans)

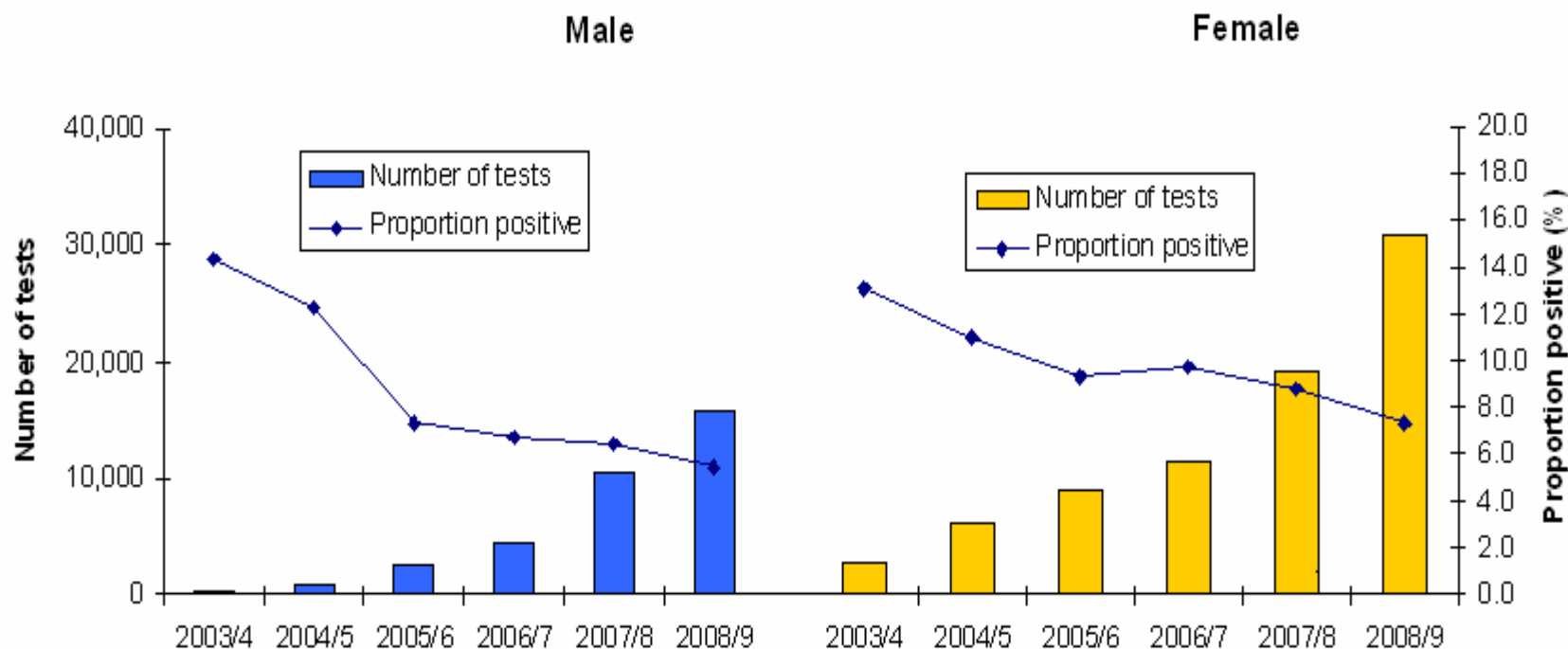

Chlamydia testing volumes: April 2003 – March 2009



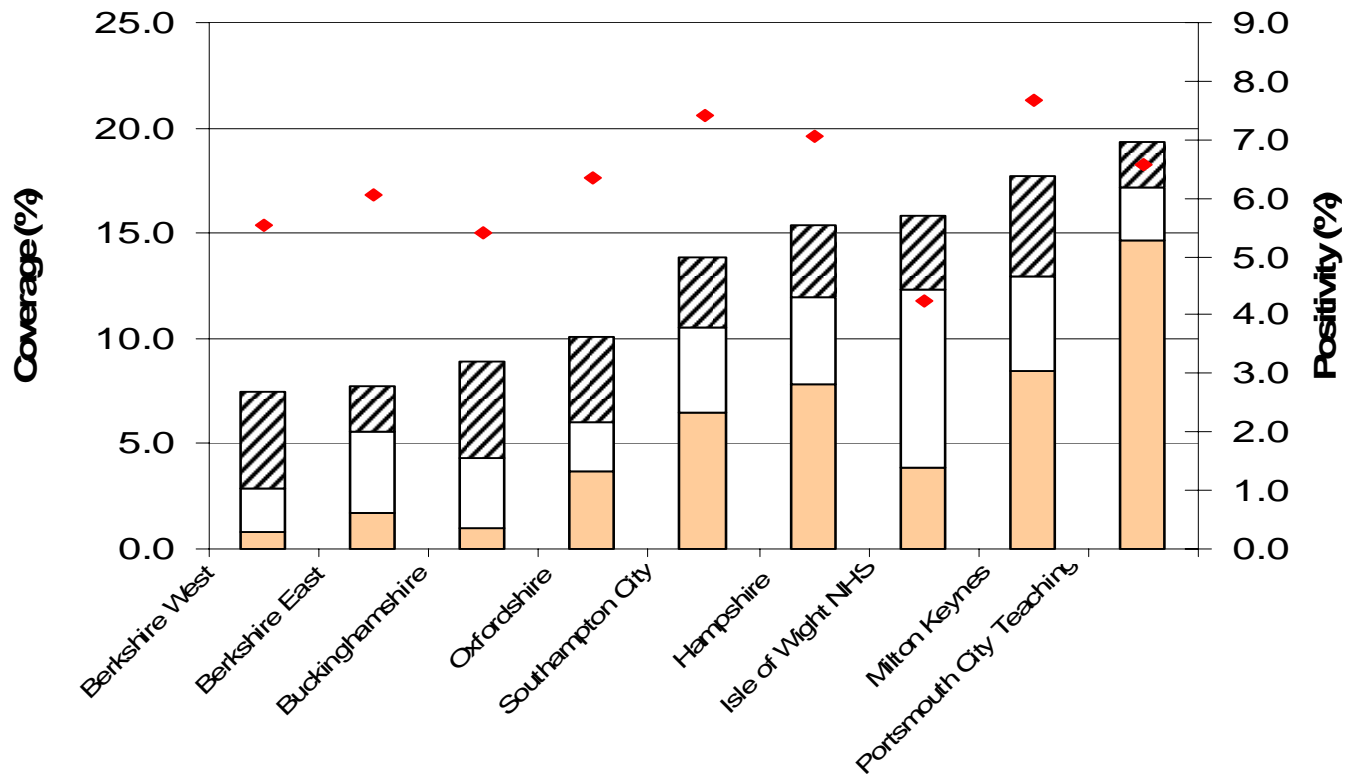

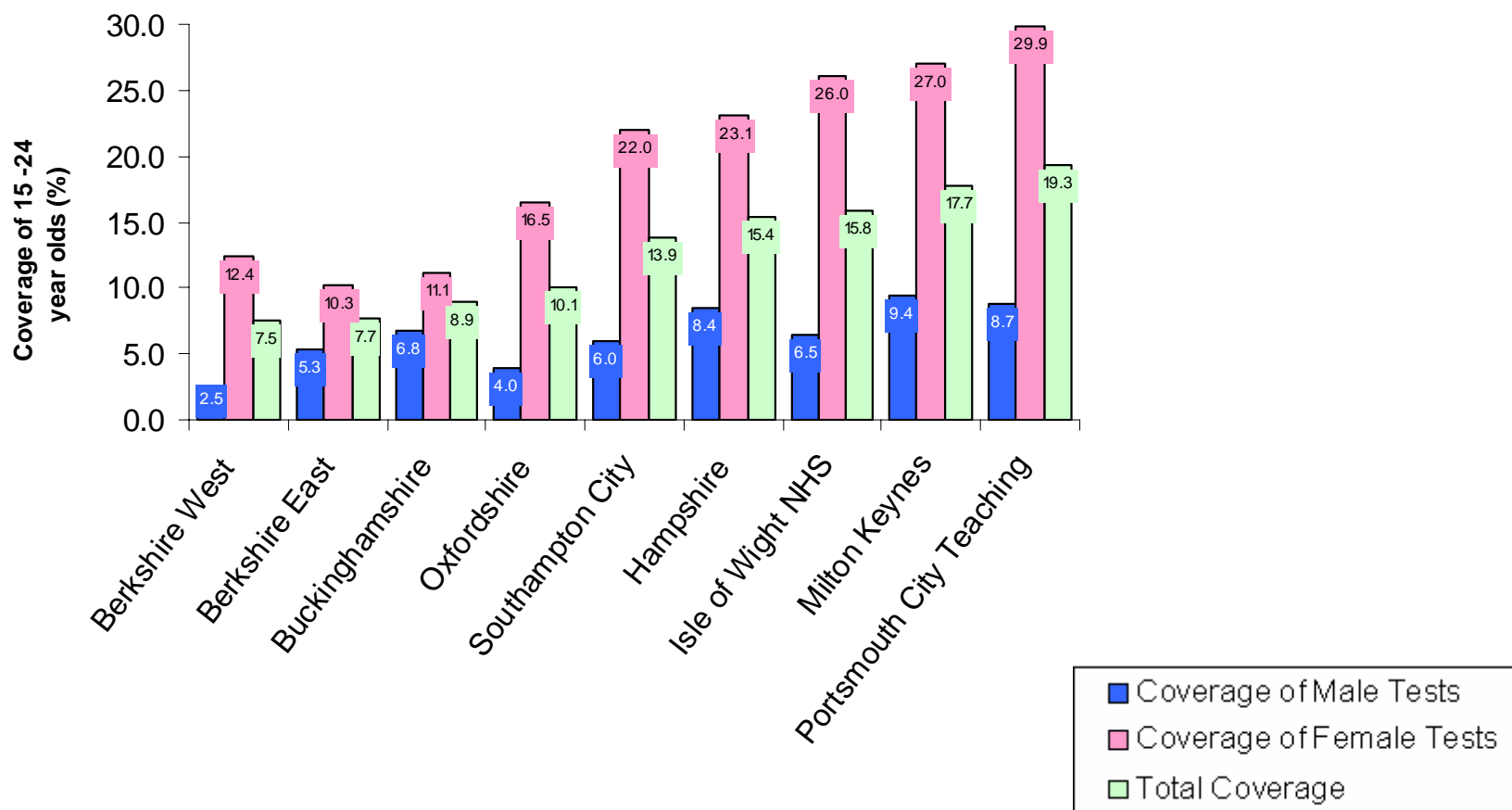
Vital Signs Indicator: April 08 - March 2009

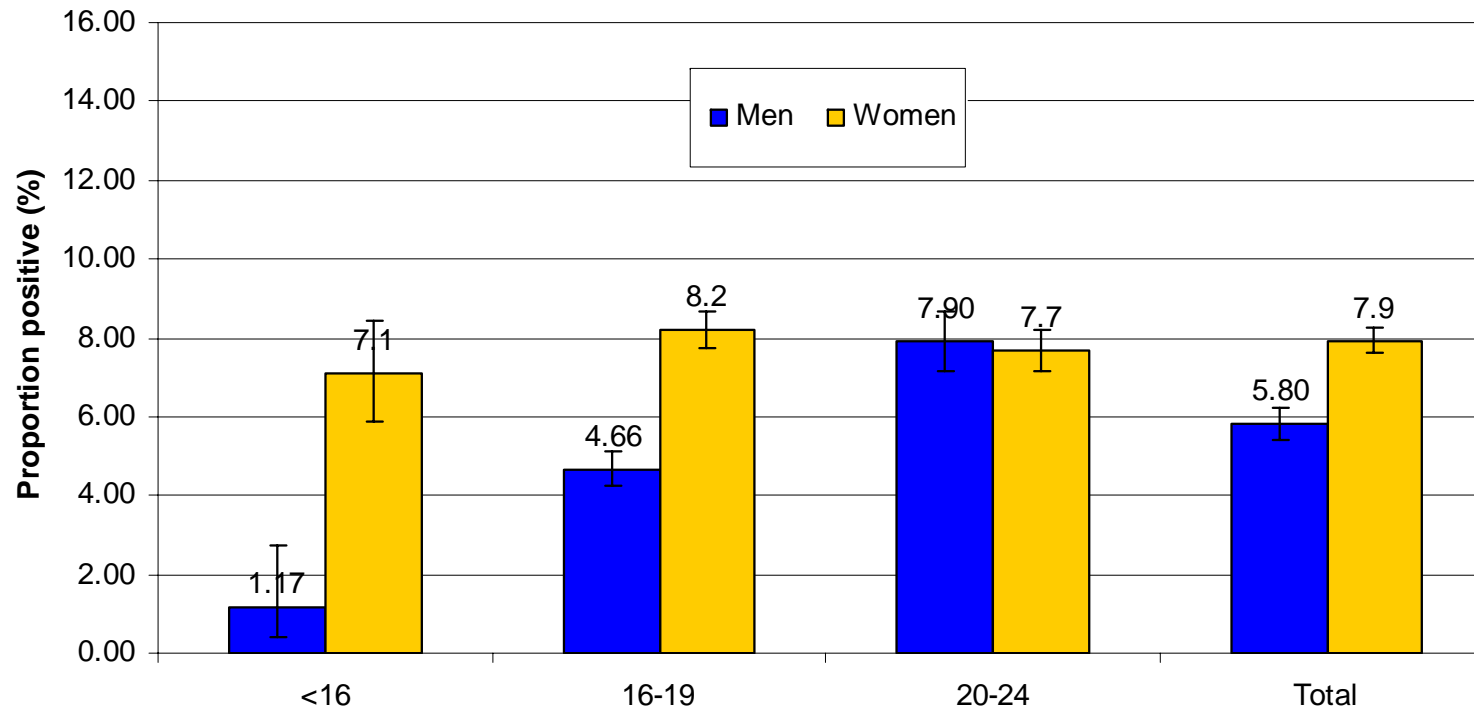
Coverage by Gender: April 08 - March 09

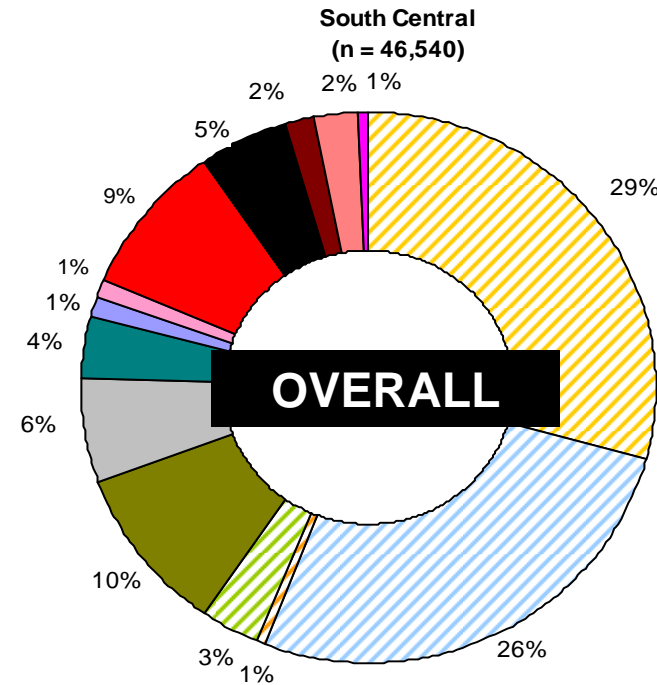
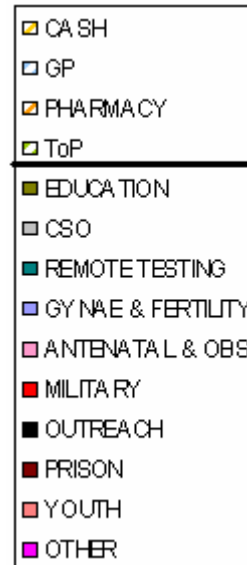
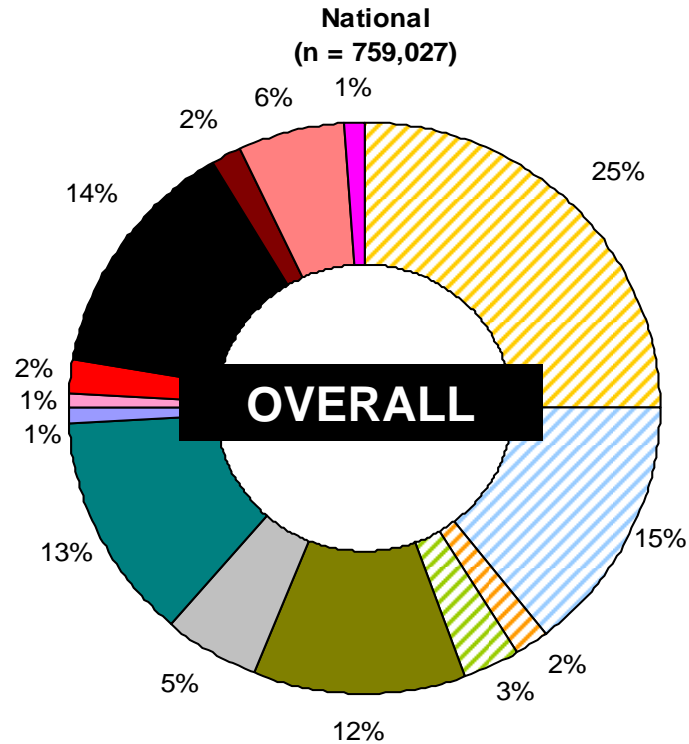
Proportion positive by age and sex: Apr 08 – Mar 09

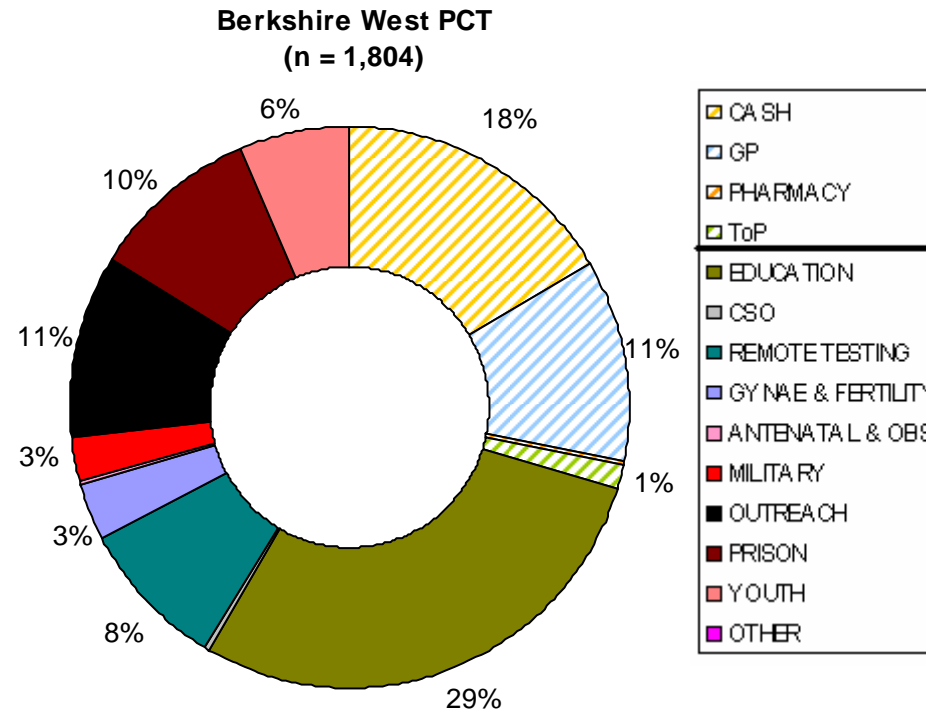

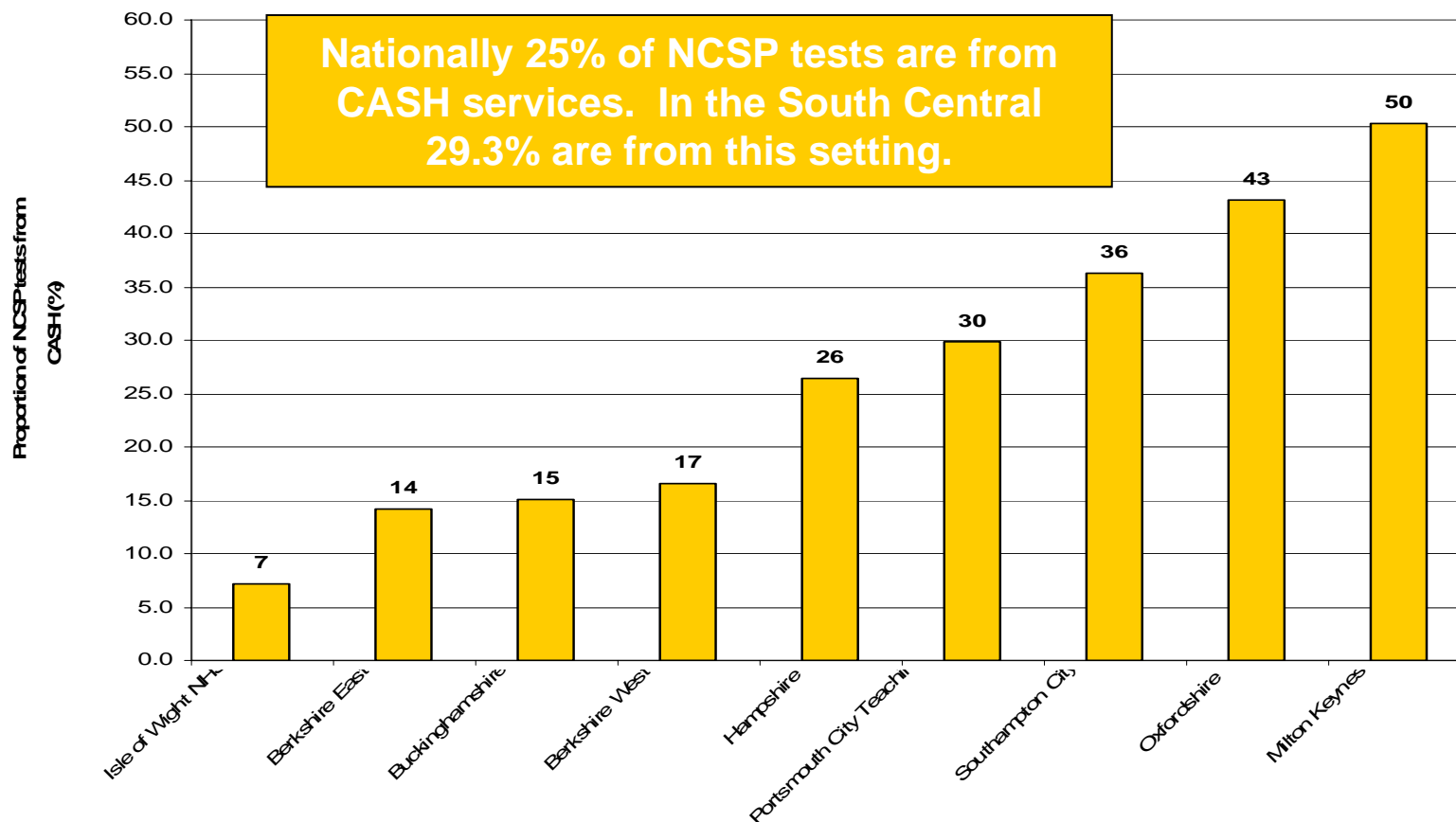


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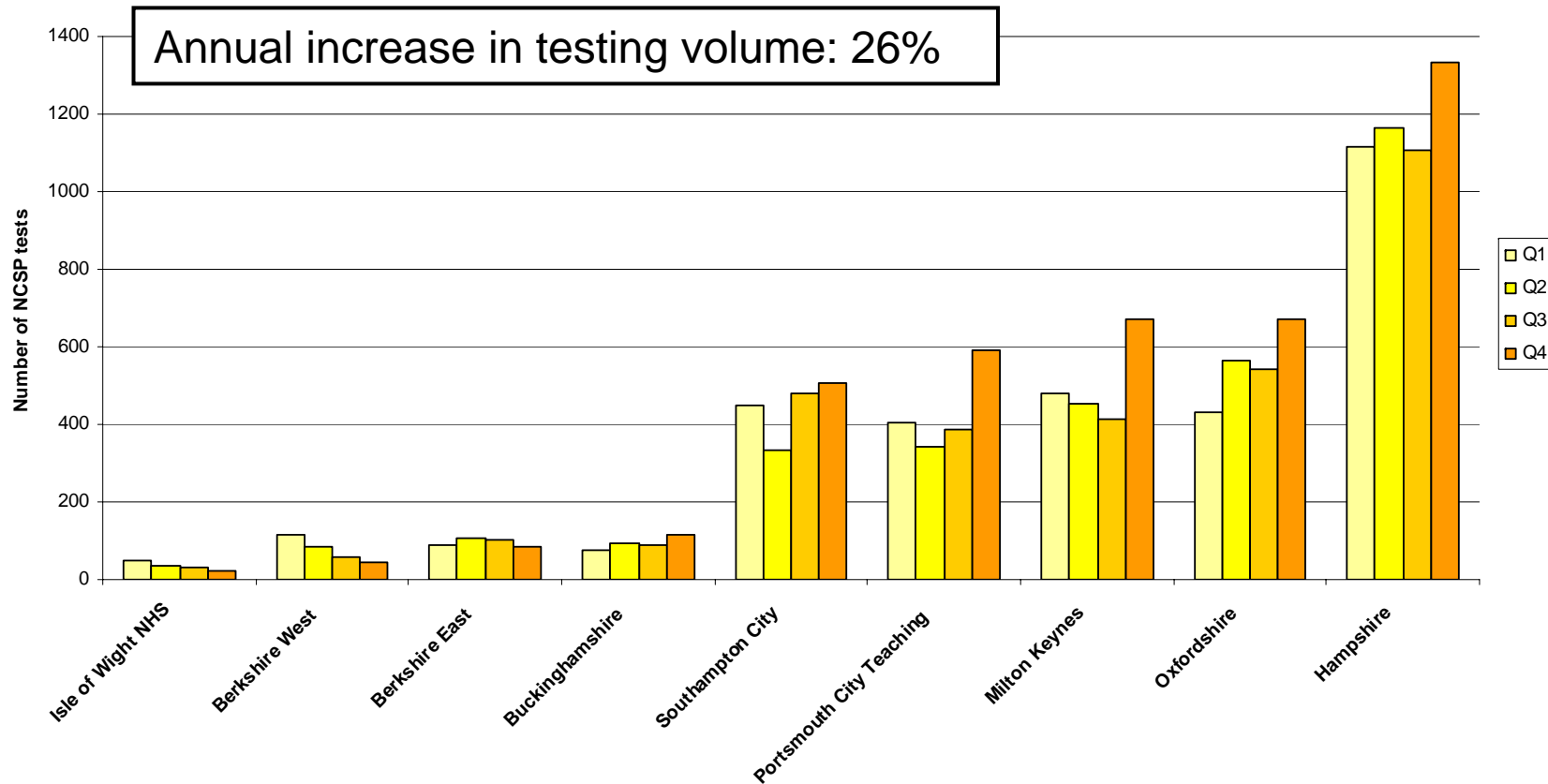

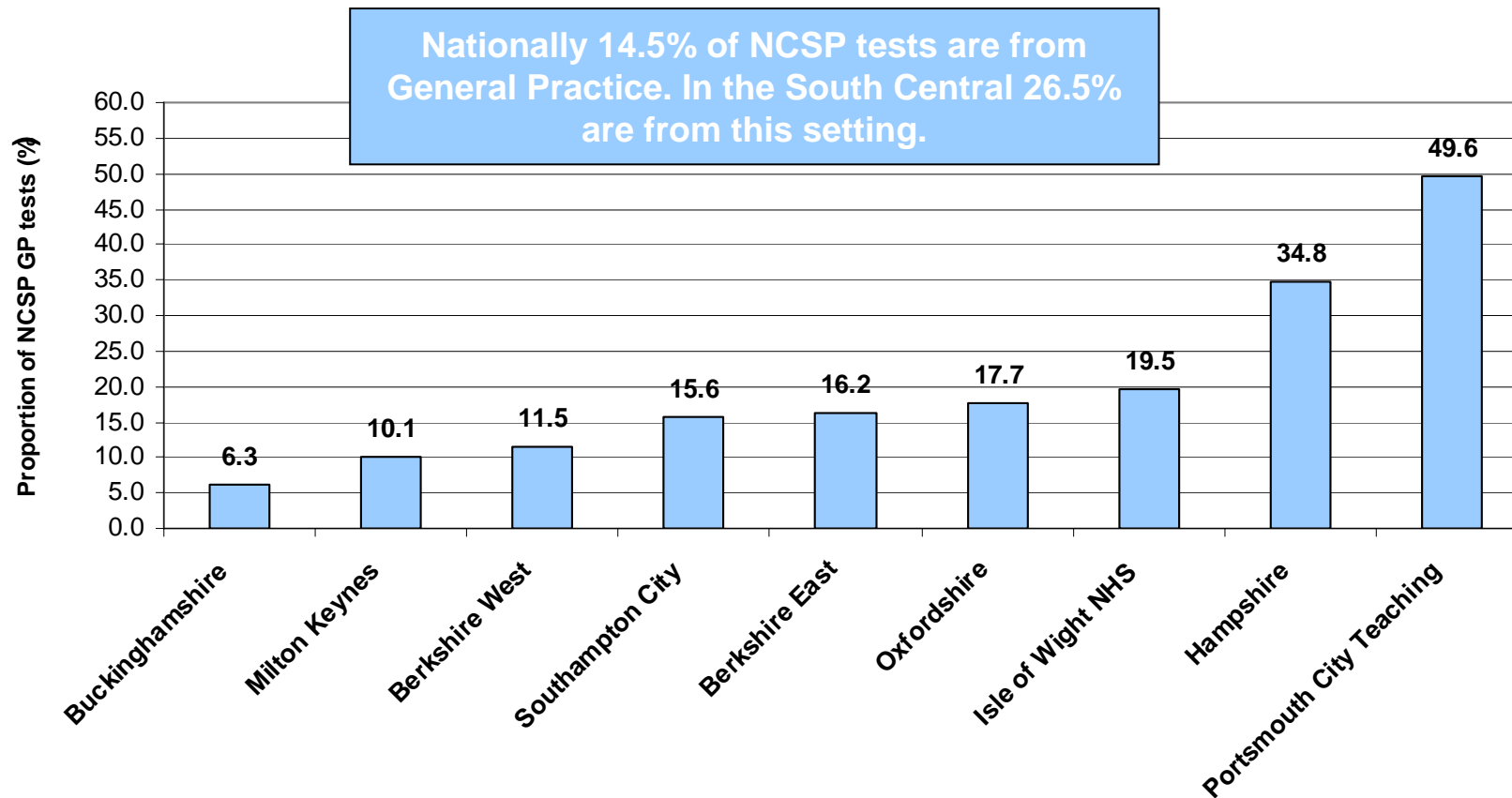

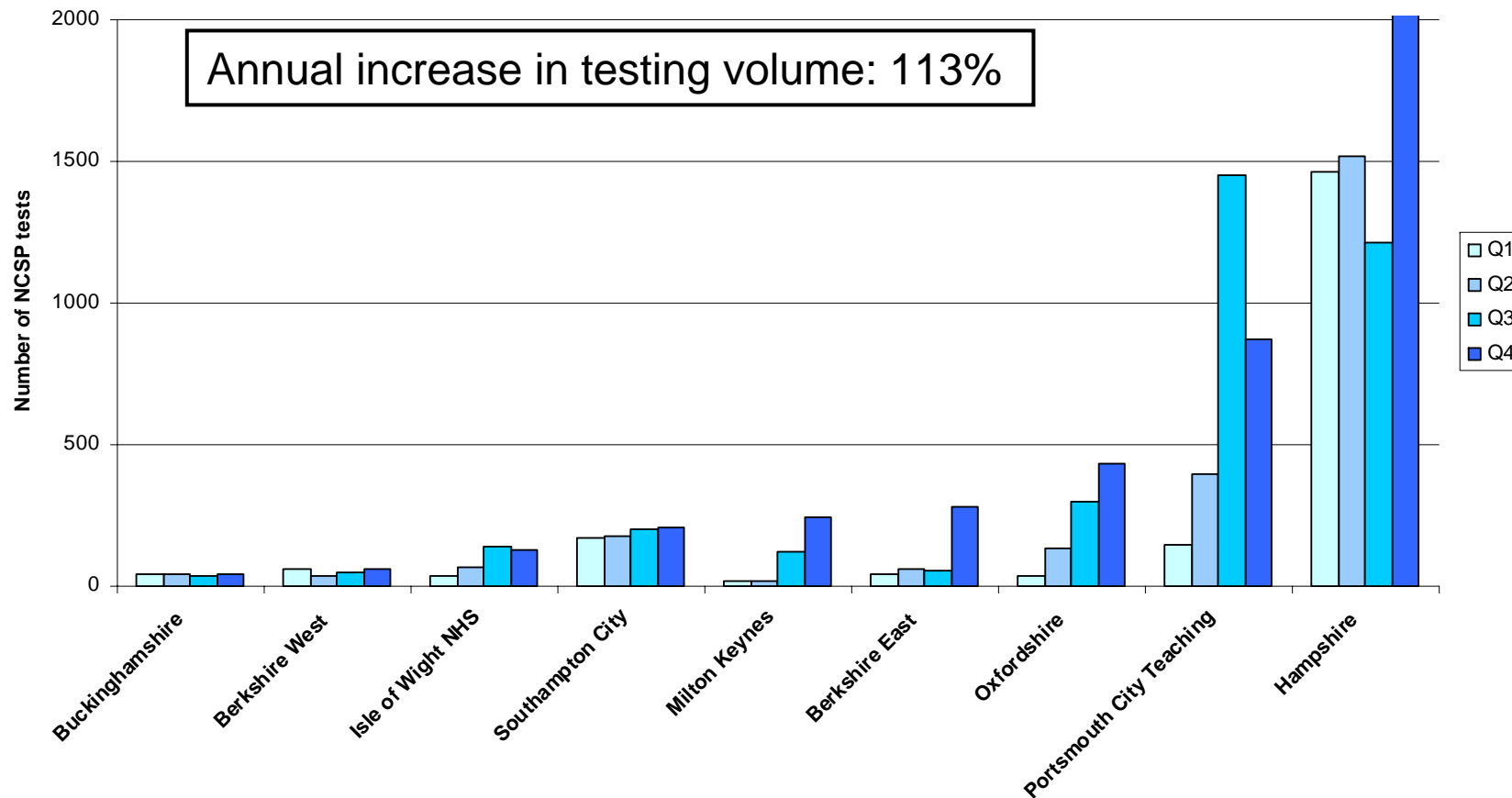

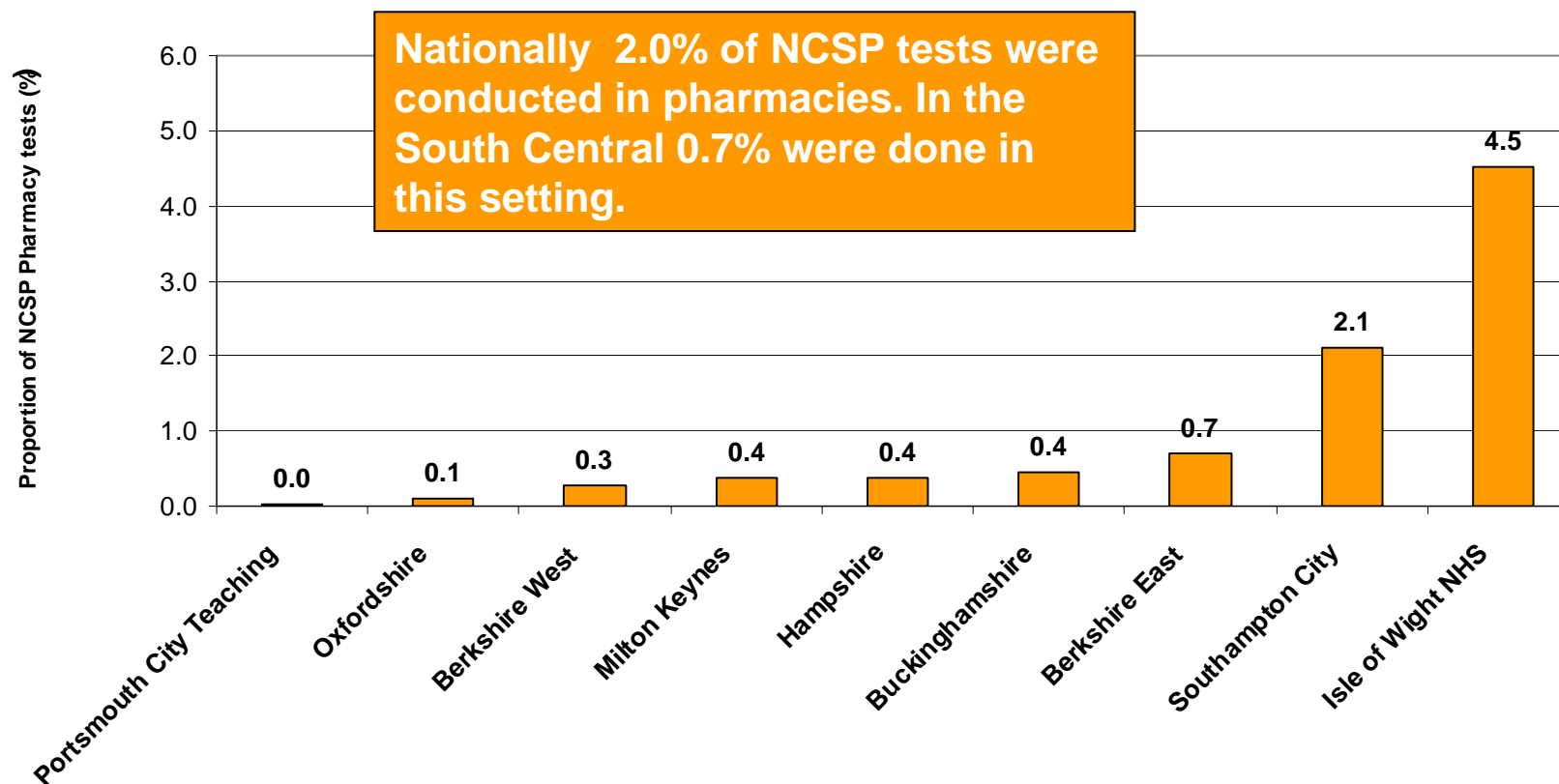
Engagement of General Practices

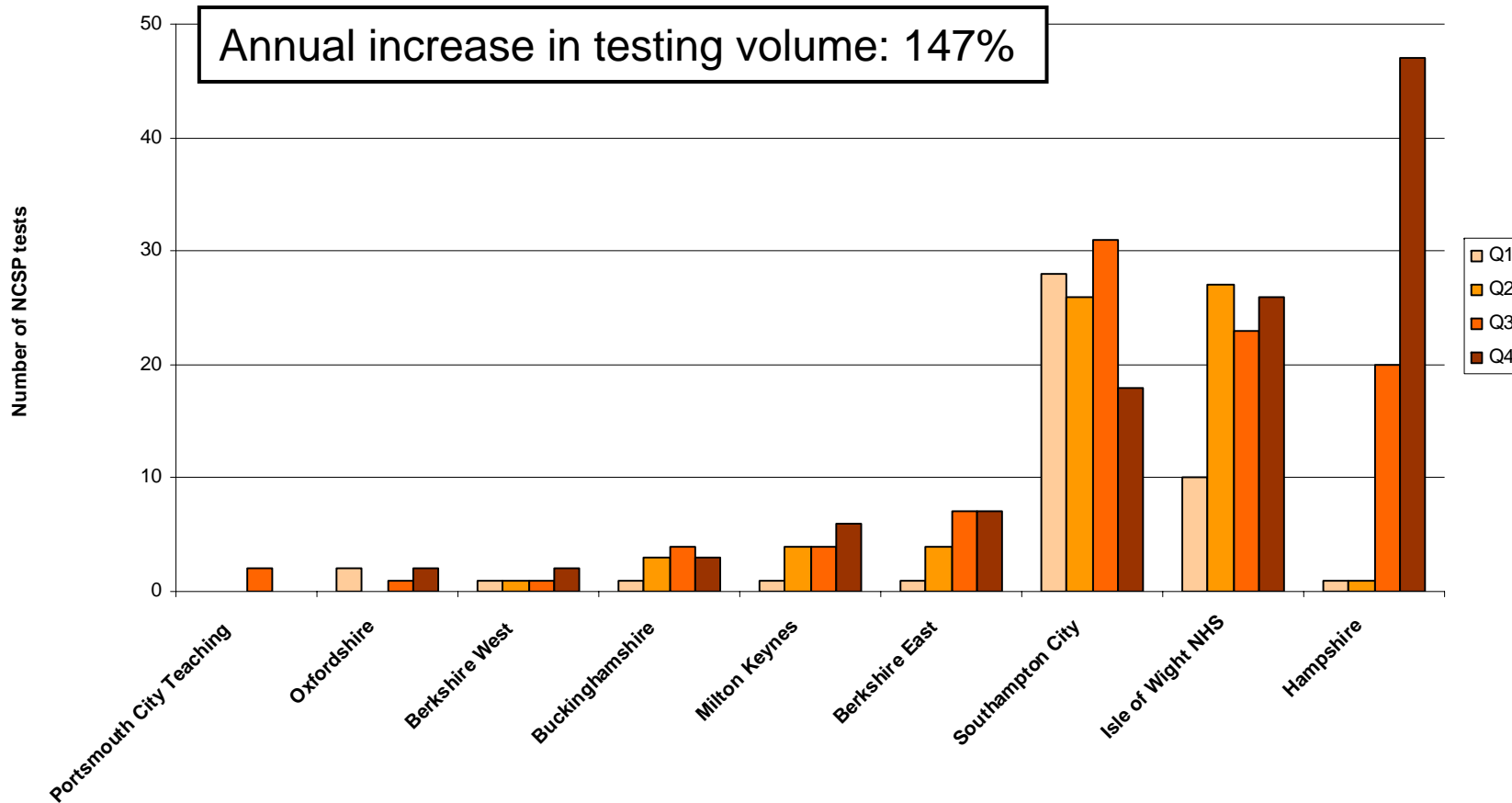

Proportion of tests from Pharmacies: Apr 08 - Mar 09



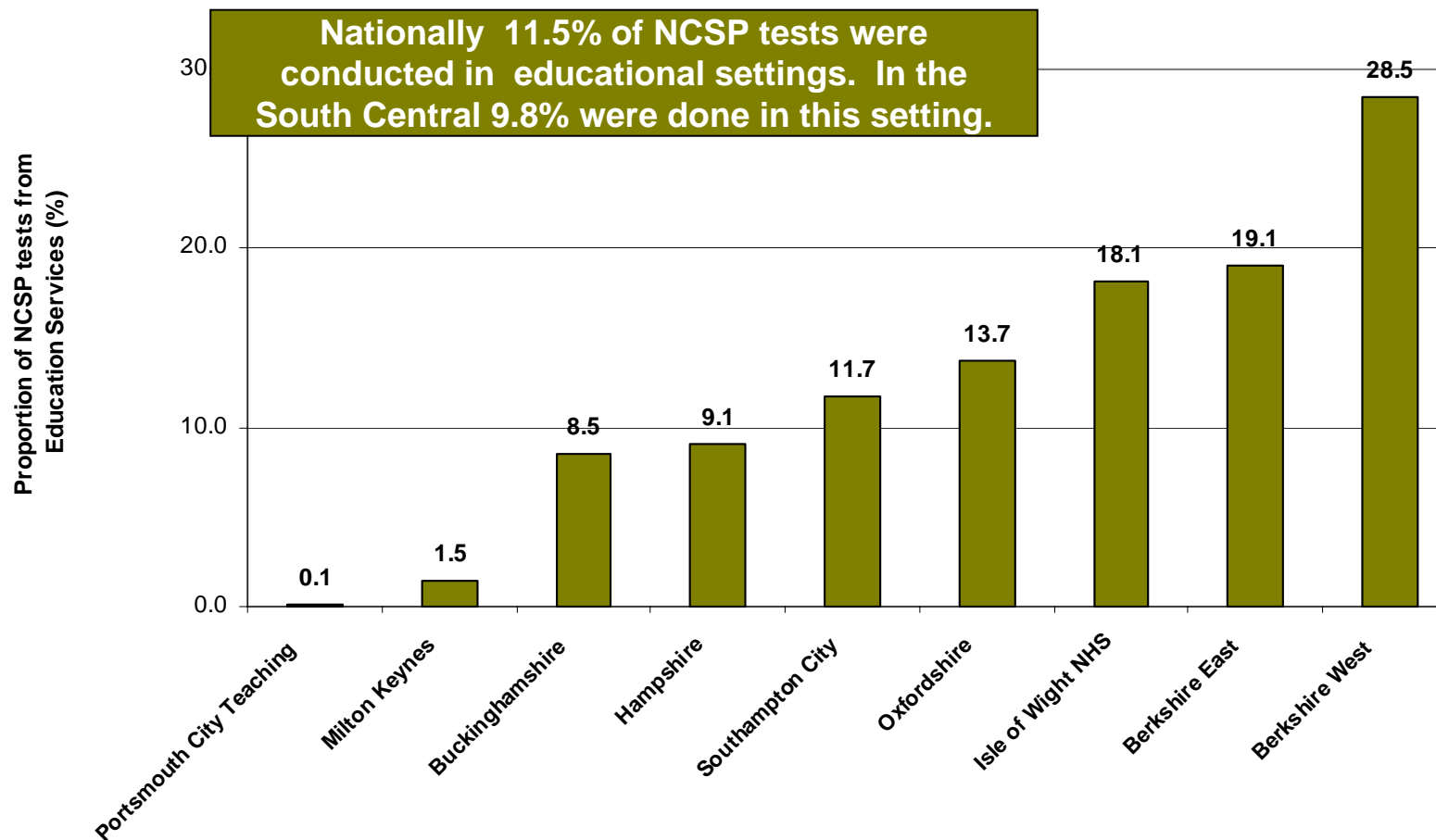

Proportion of tests from Educational Services Apr 08 - Mar 09



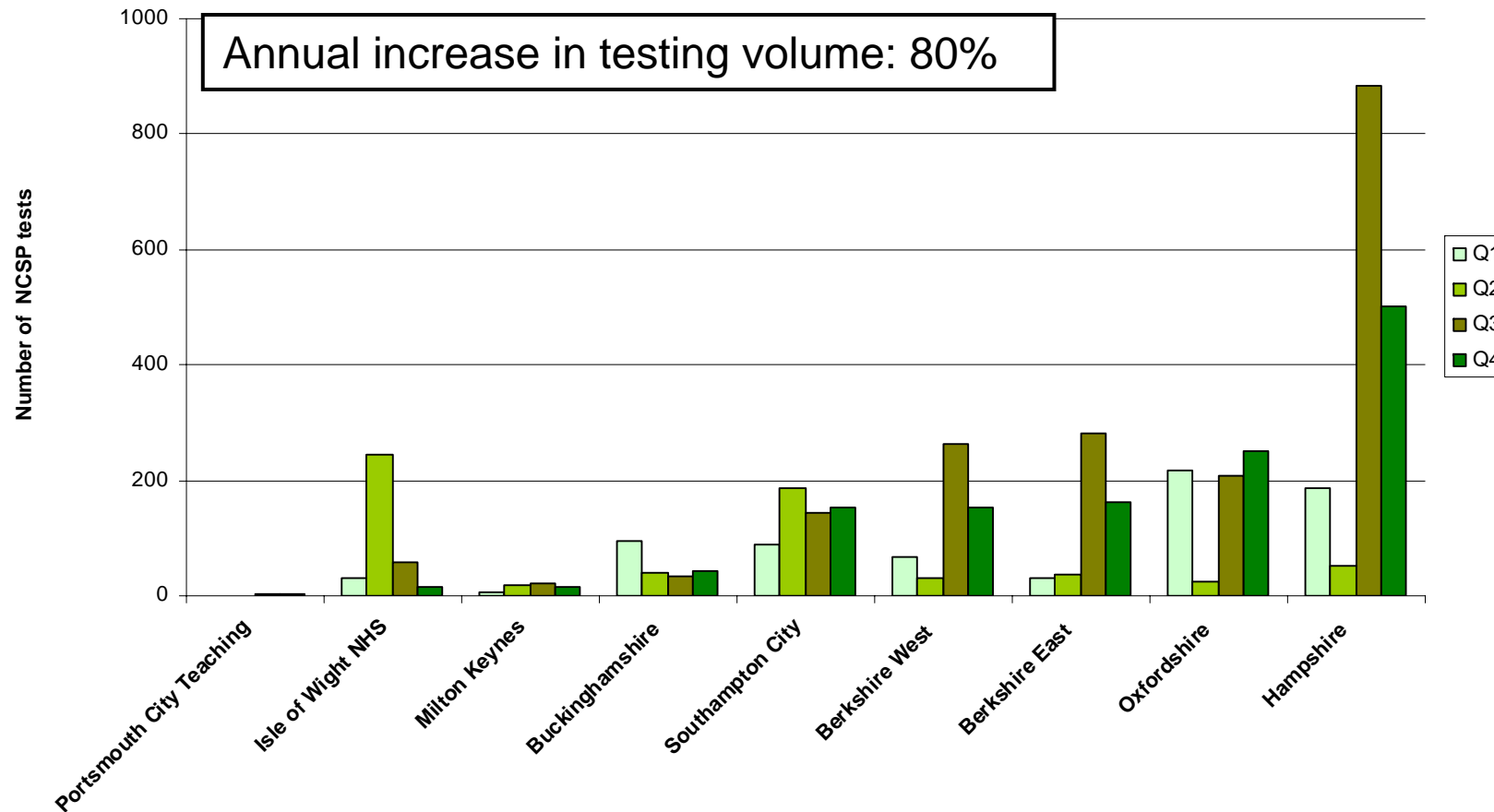

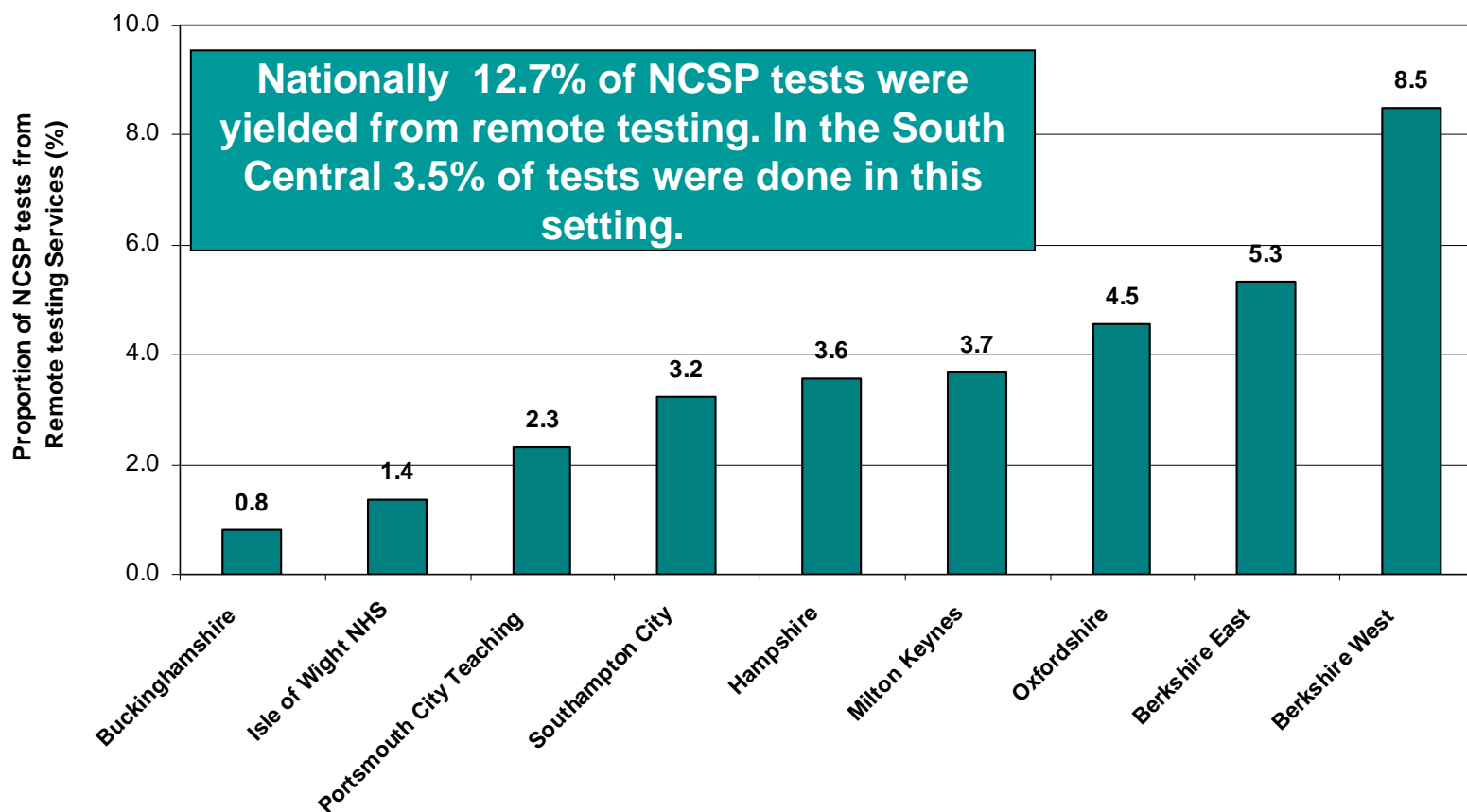
Engagement of Educational Services

Proportion of tests from remote testing: Apr 08- Mar 2009

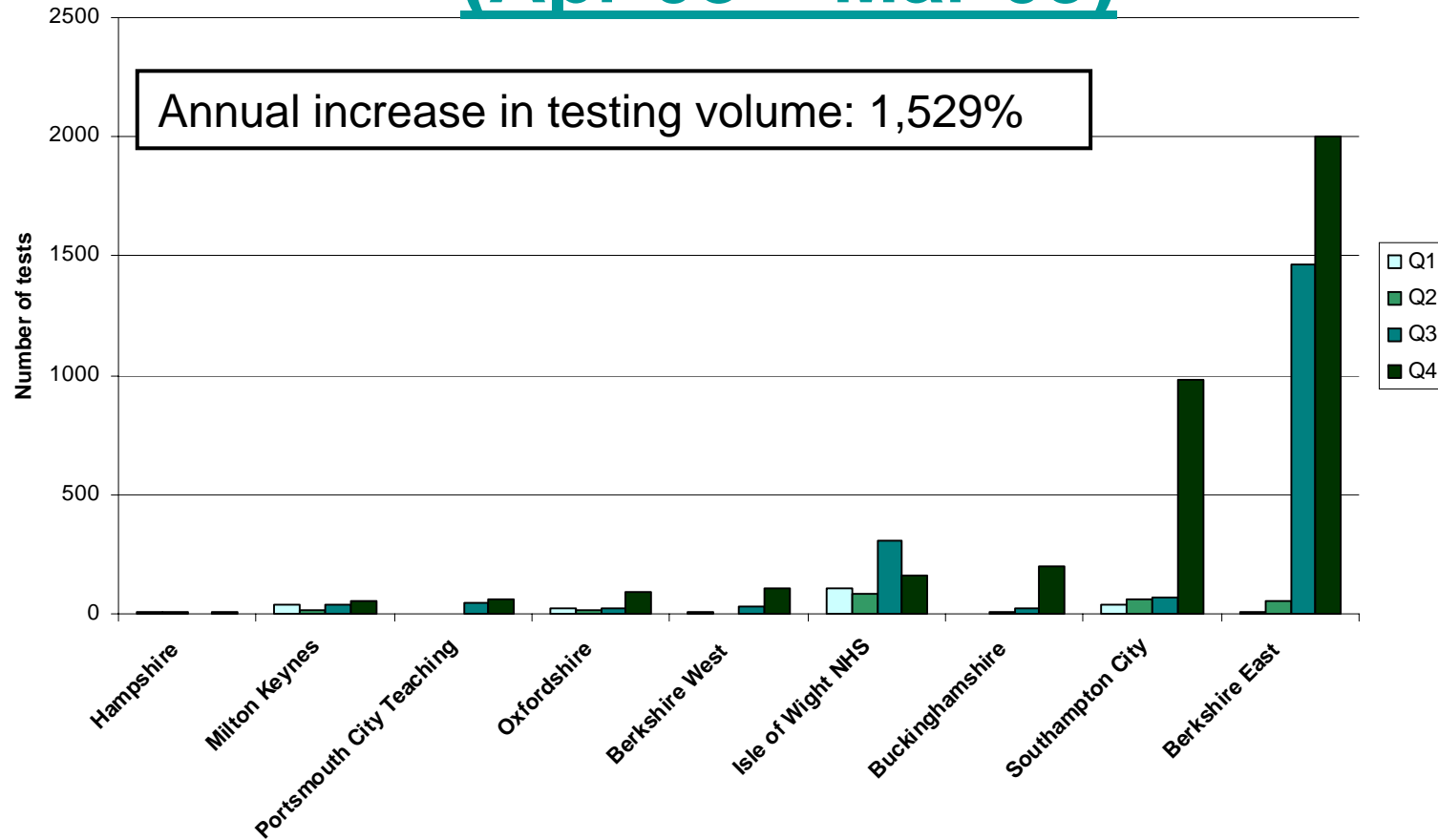

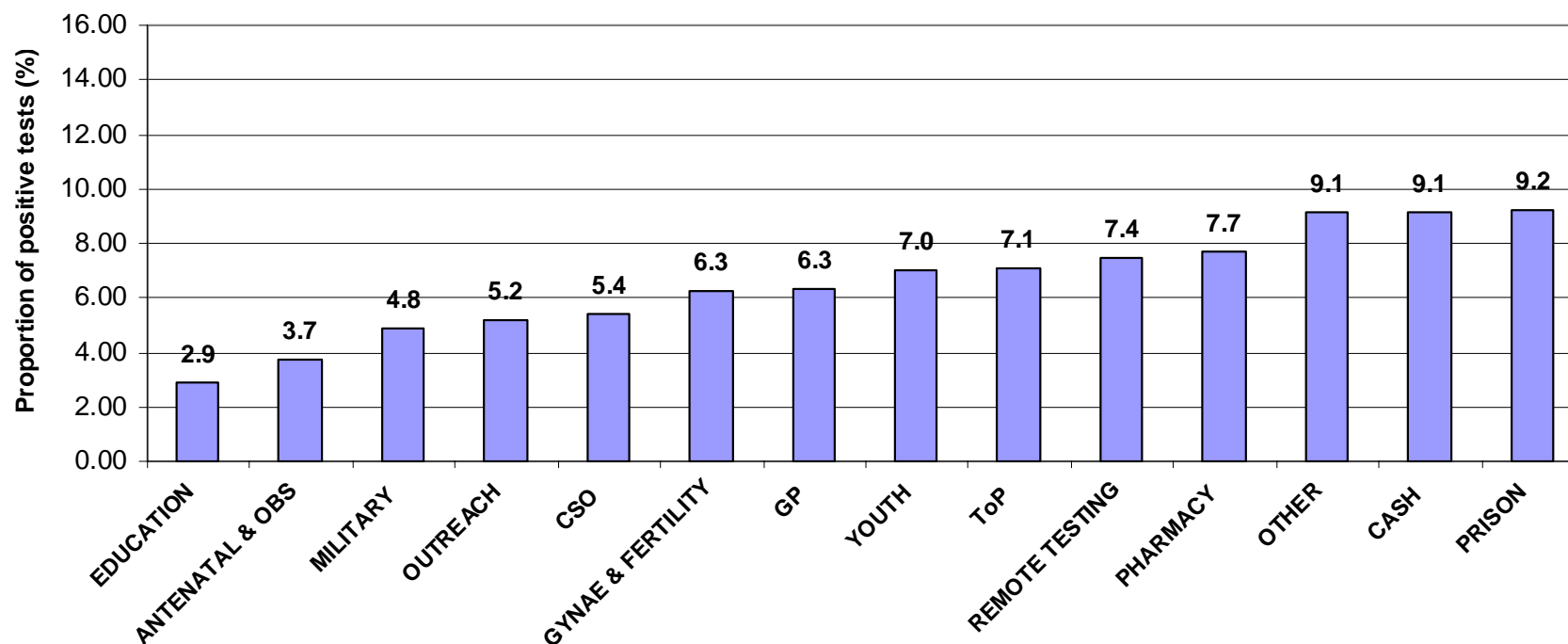


Engagement of remote testing (Apr 08 – Mar 09)

Positivity by Venue Type: Apr 08 - Mar 09

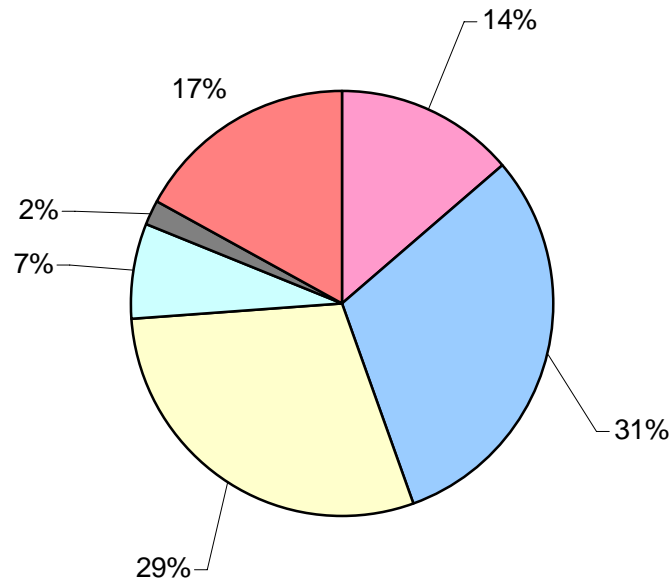

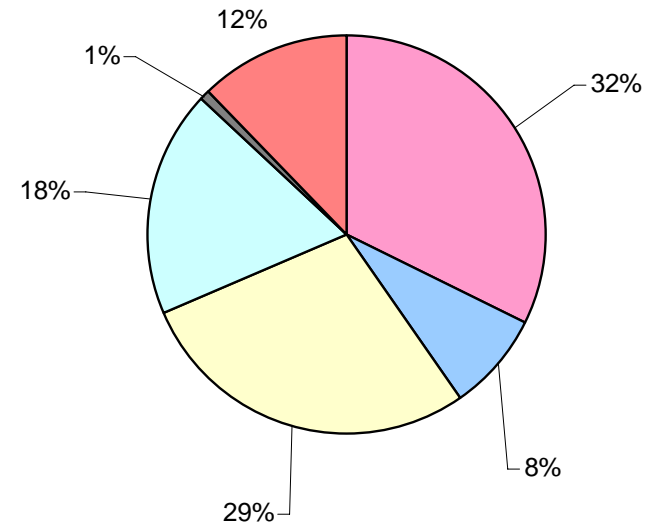

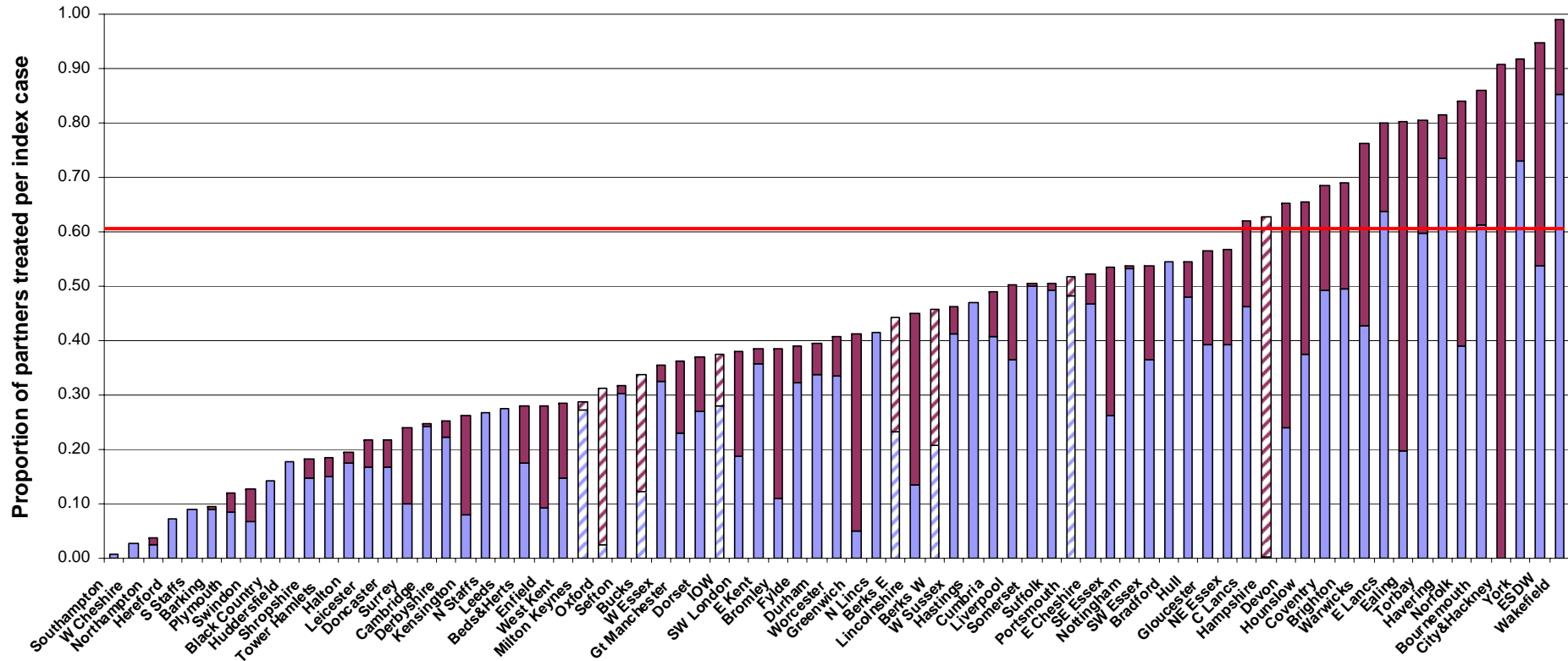

Proportion of partners treated per index case: South Central (Apr – Dec 2008)

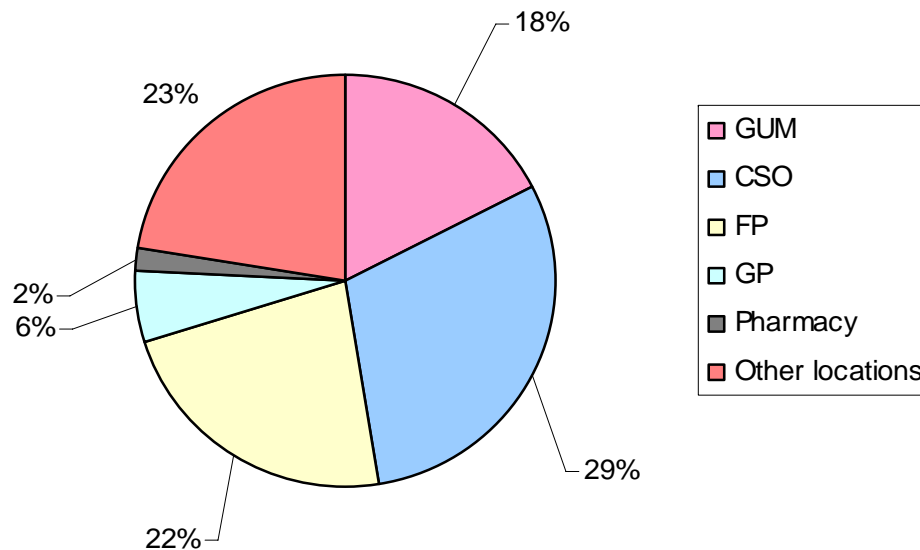

■ Clinician confirmed treatment

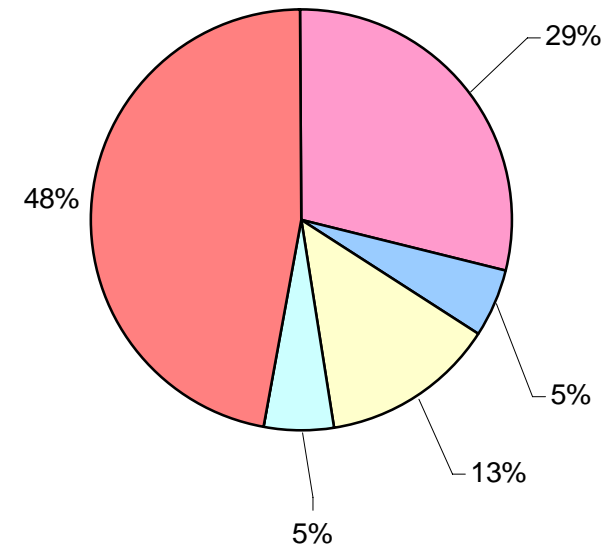
