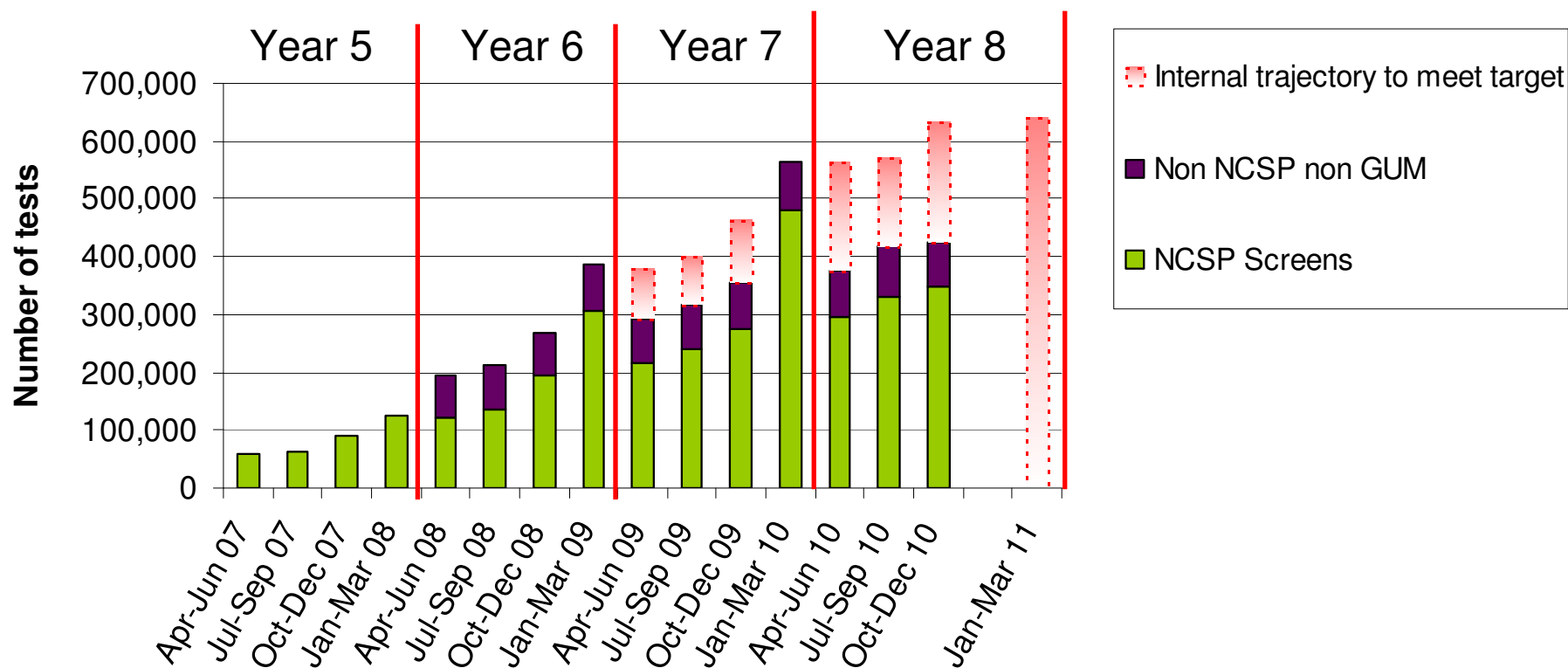
England: Profile

- Over 6,884,600 young people aged 15-24 years in England (2006-based ONS population projections for 2010)
 - Vital Signs target (17%) – 1,138,337 (2008/2009 PCT plans)
 - England coverage in 2008 / 2009 was 15.9%
 - Vital Signs target (25%) – 1,724,575 (2006-based ONS population projections for 2009)
 - England coverage in 2009 / 2010 was 22.1%
 - Vital Signs target (35%) – 2,409,610 (2006-based ONS population projections for 2010)

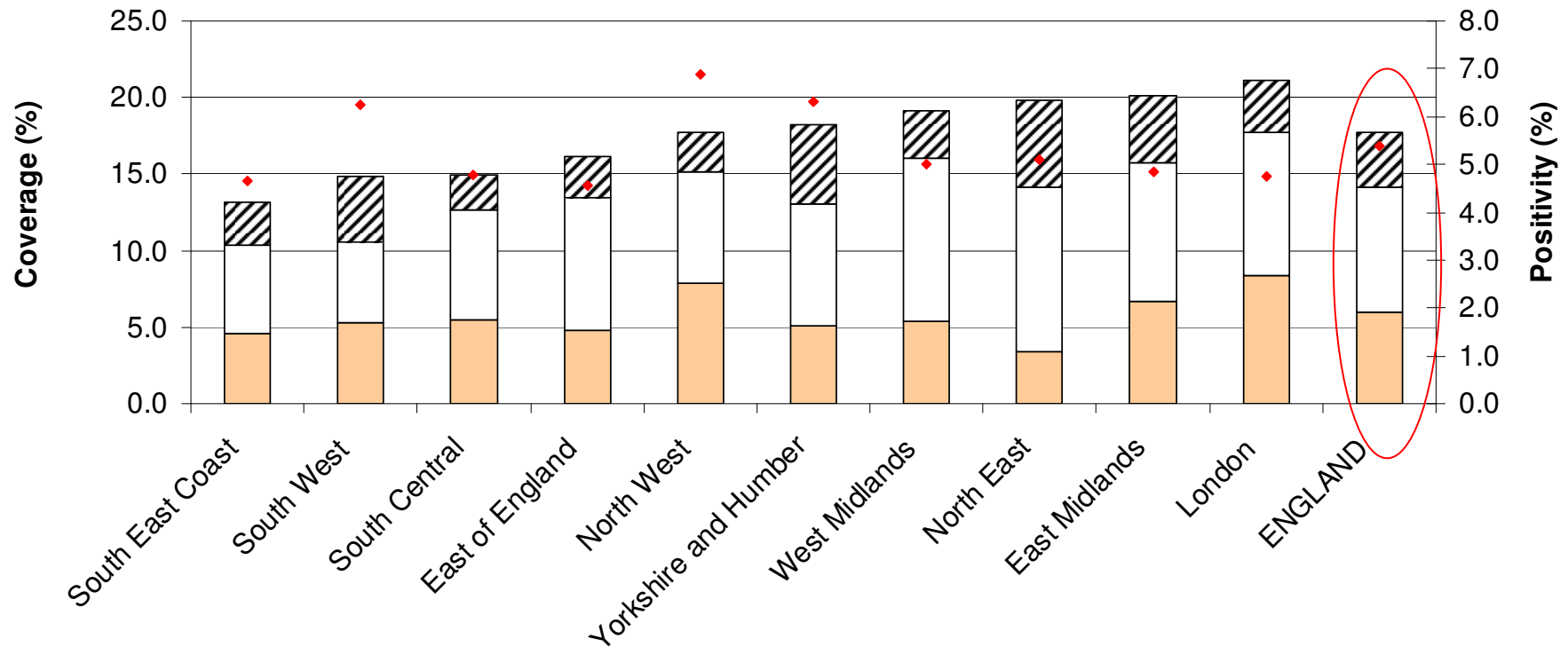
Actual and projected chlamydia testing volumes: April 2007 – March 2011

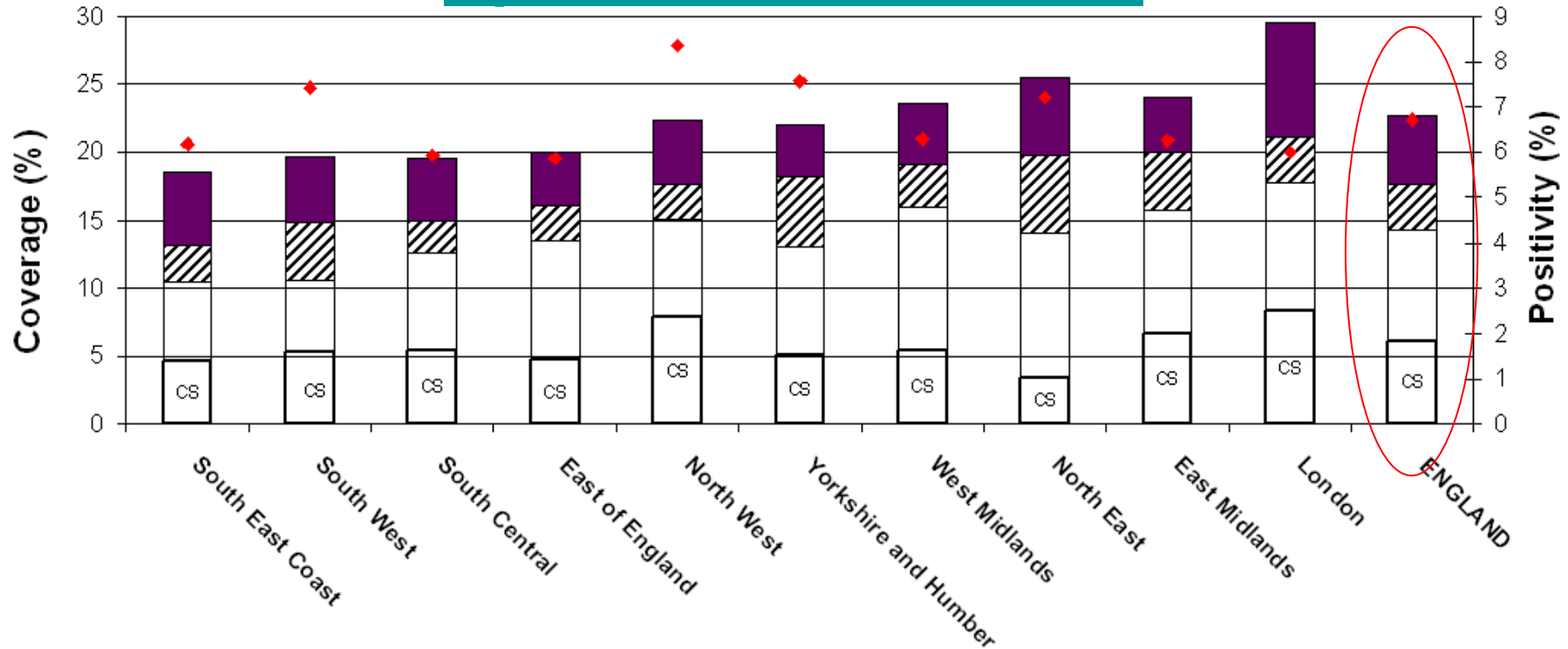

Coverage and Positivity including GUM Data* April – December 2010



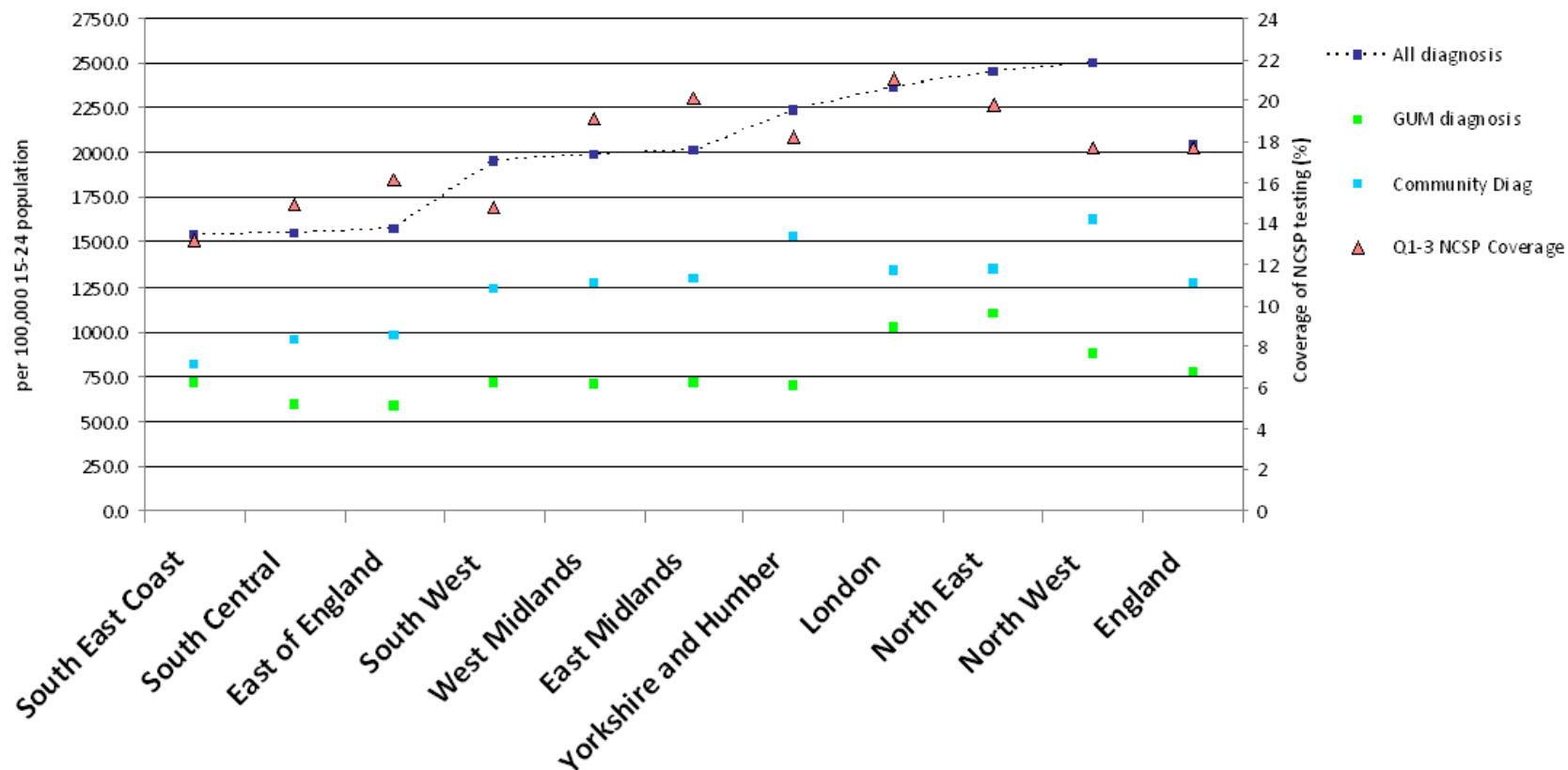

Diagnosis rates per 100,000 15-24 population by PCT, Q1-3 2010



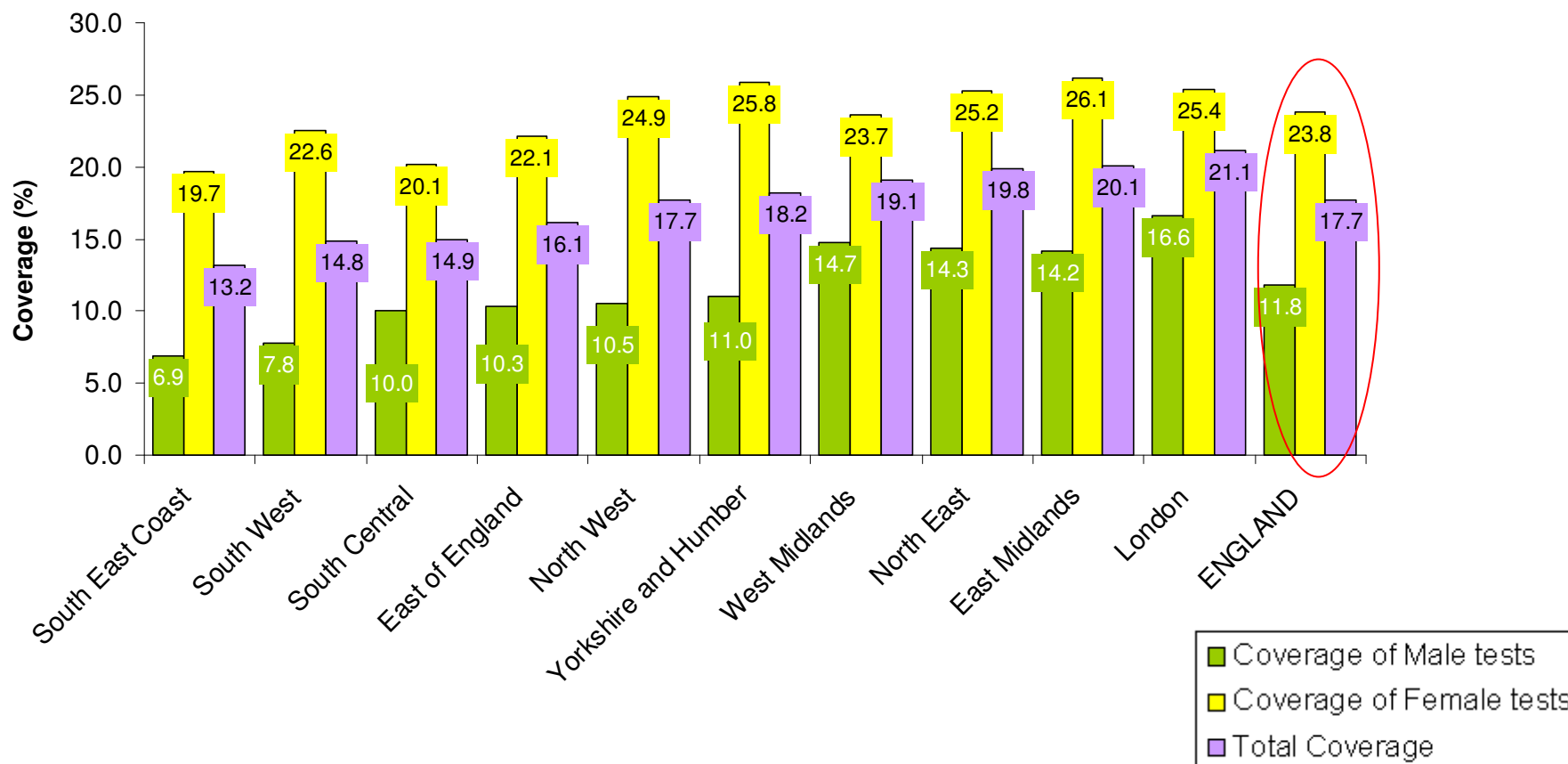

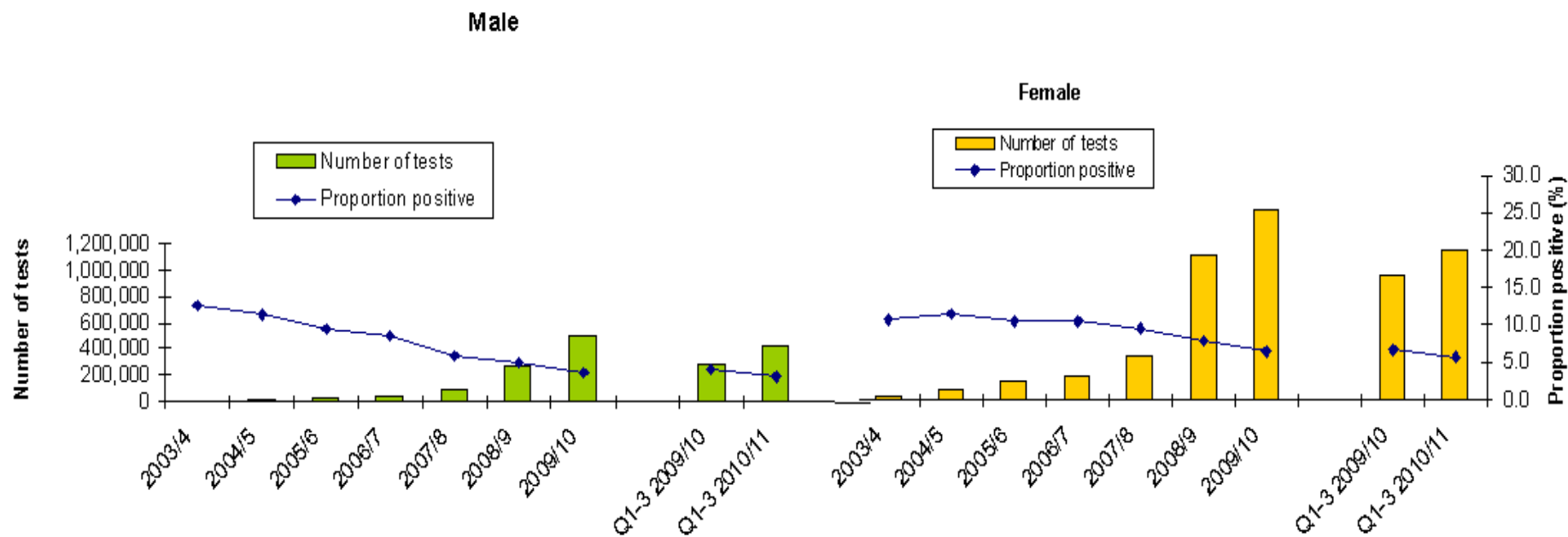
Coverage by sex April - December 2010



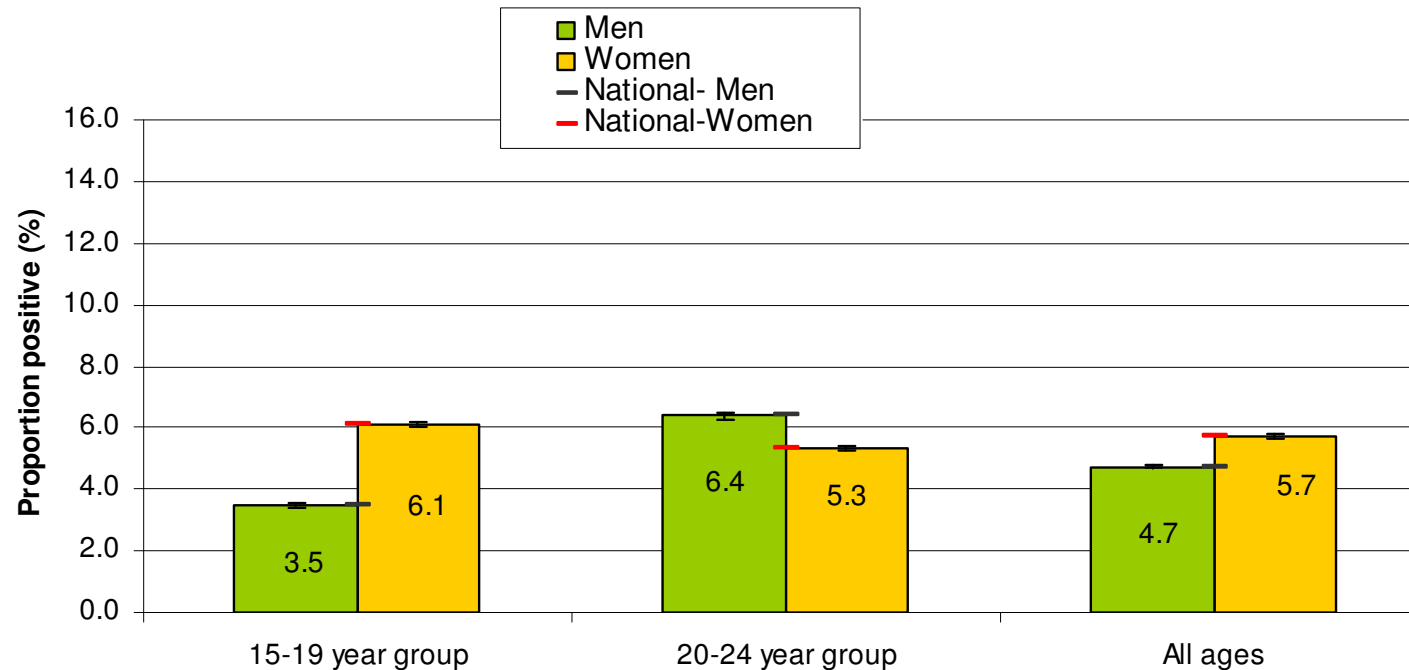

Testing volumes and proportion of positive cases by sex: April 2003 – December 2010



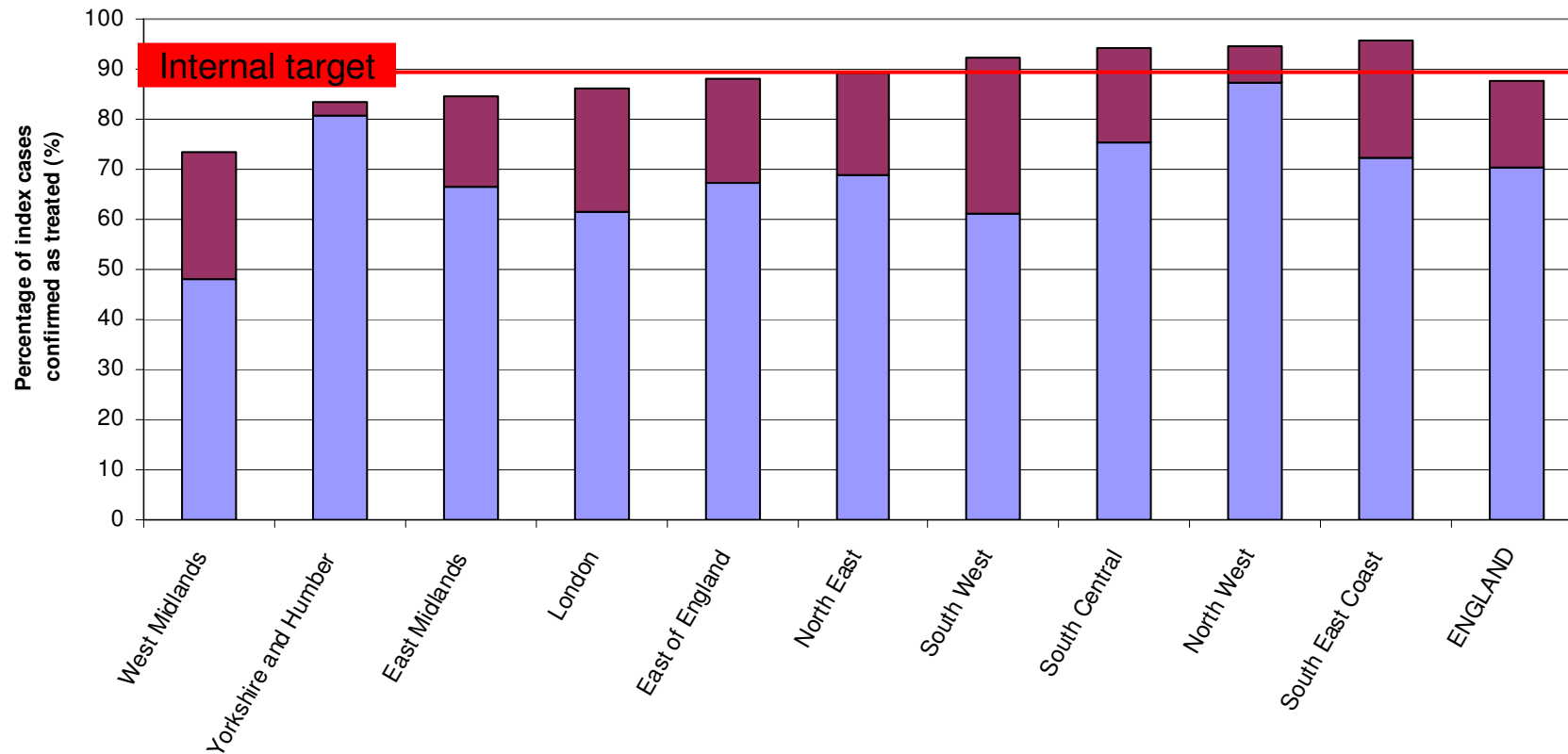
Proportion of positive cases by age and sex: April – December 10

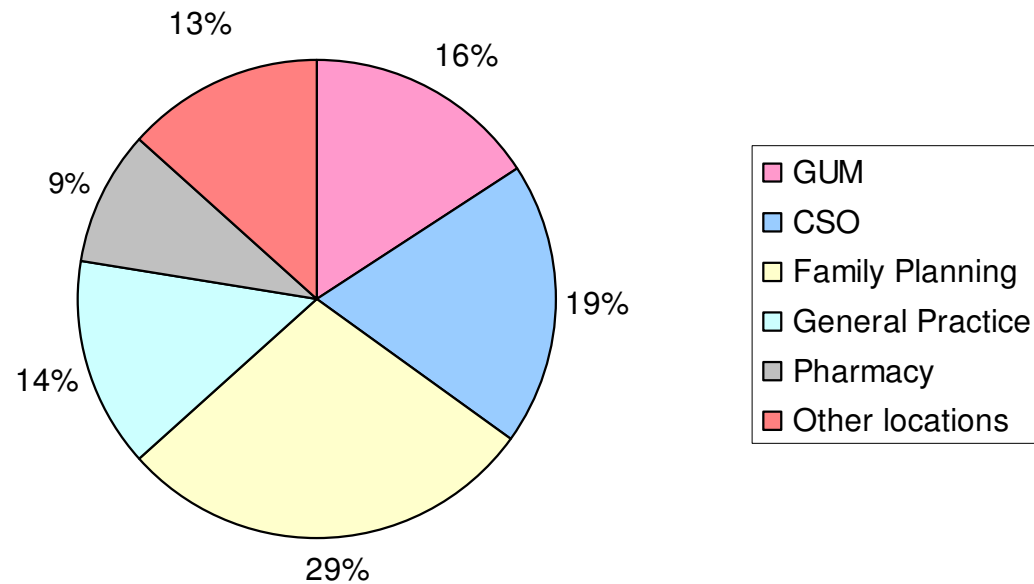

Proportion of index cases treated in various venue types: England (April 2010 – September 2010)

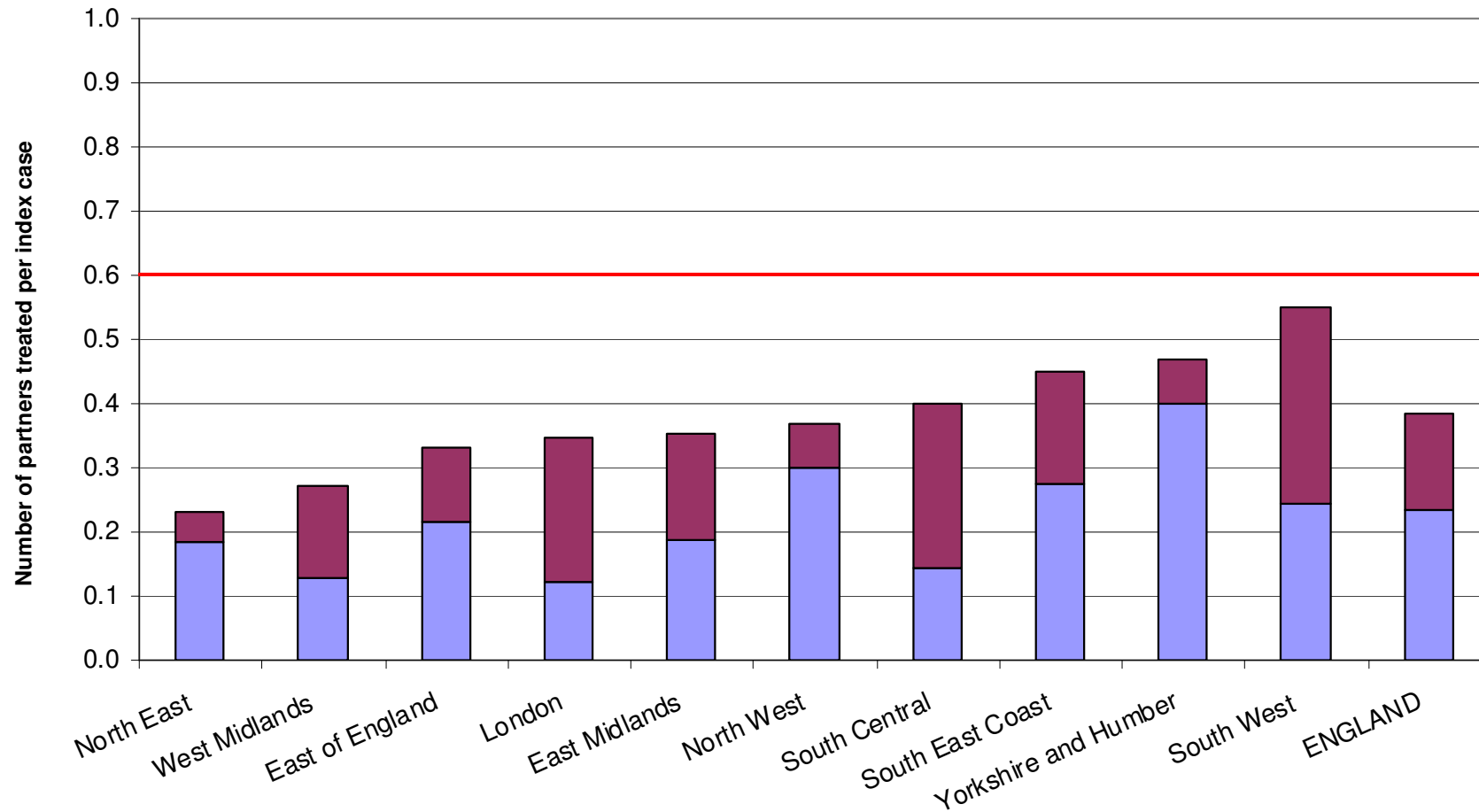

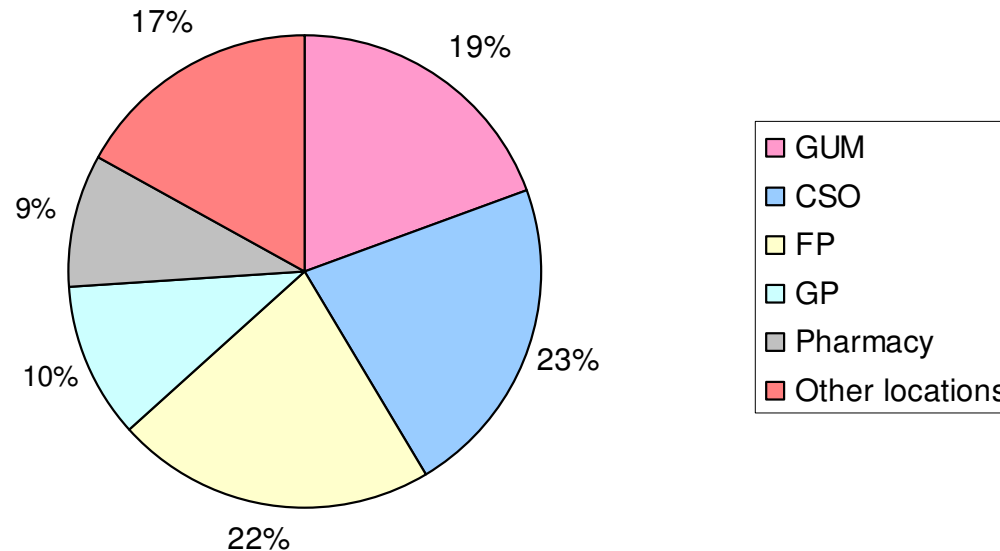

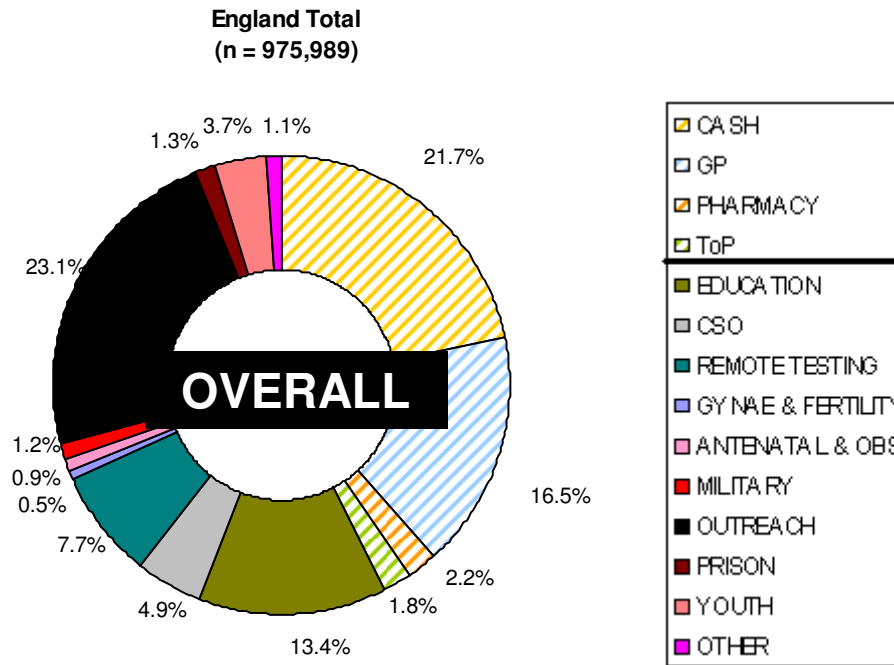

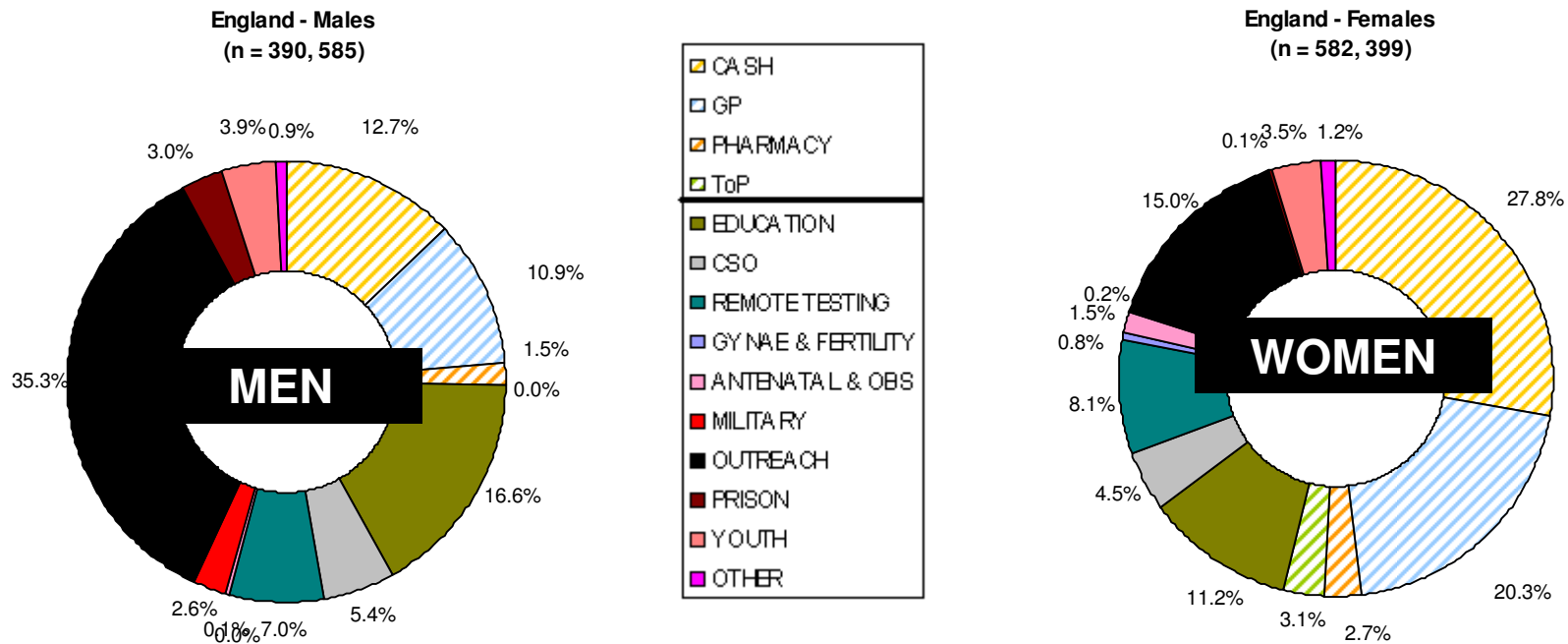

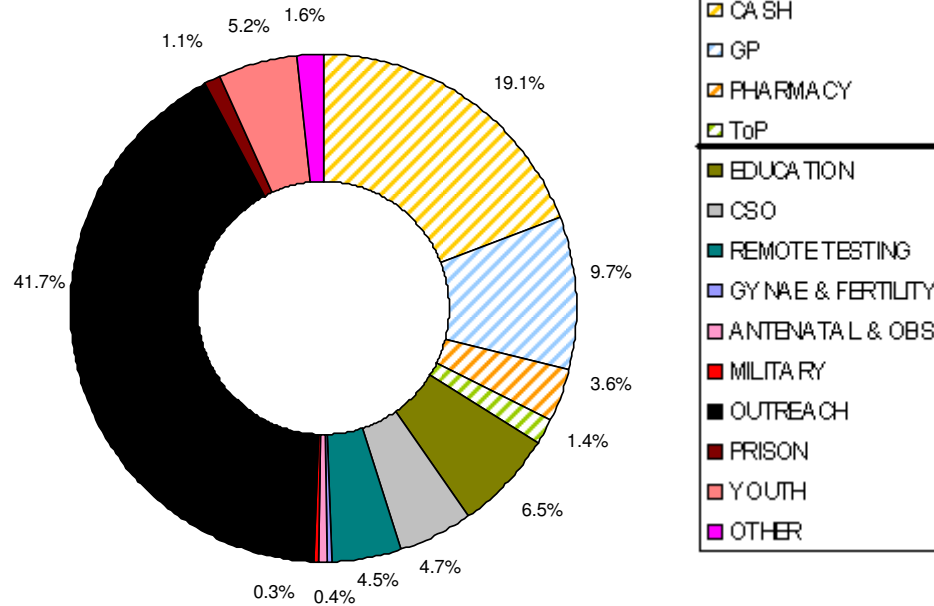

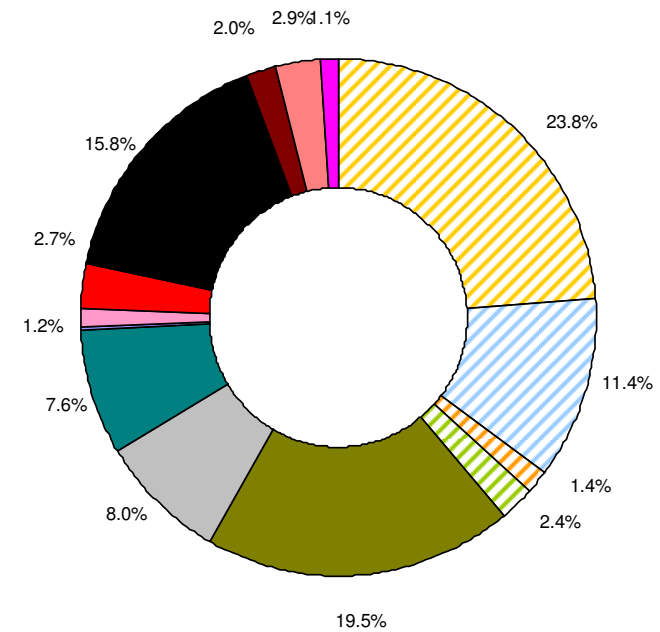

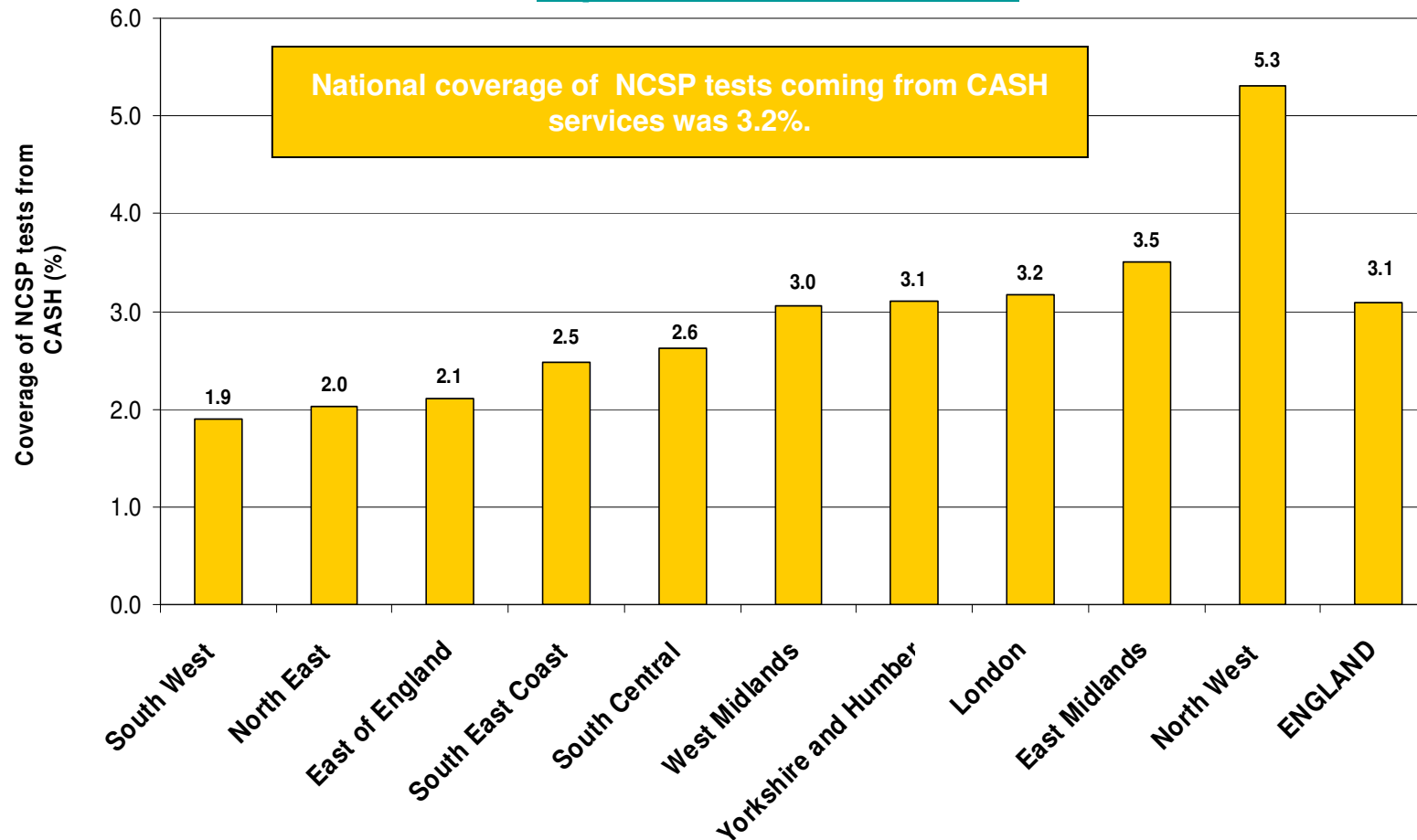

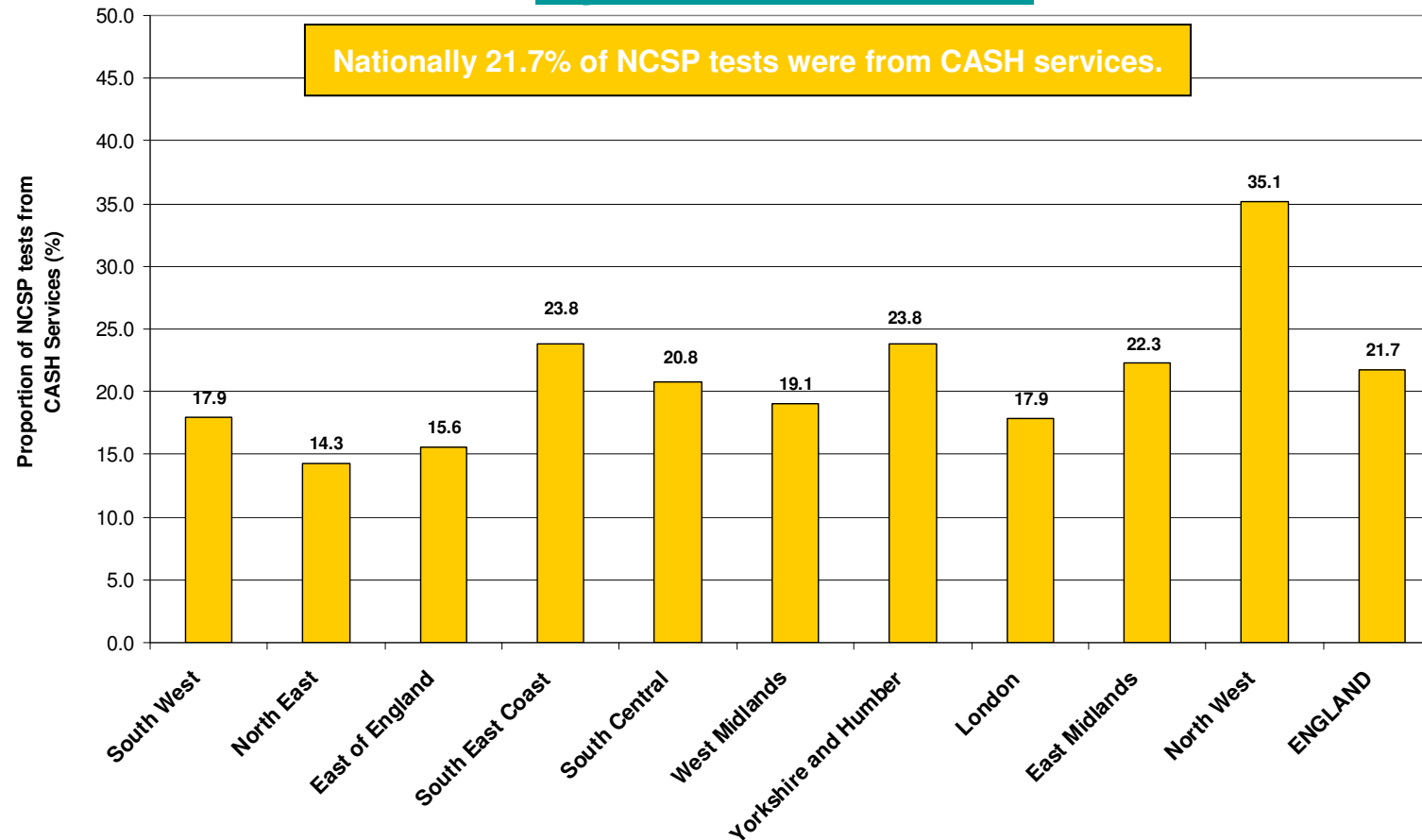

Coverage of tests from Contraception and Sexual Health services: April – December 2010

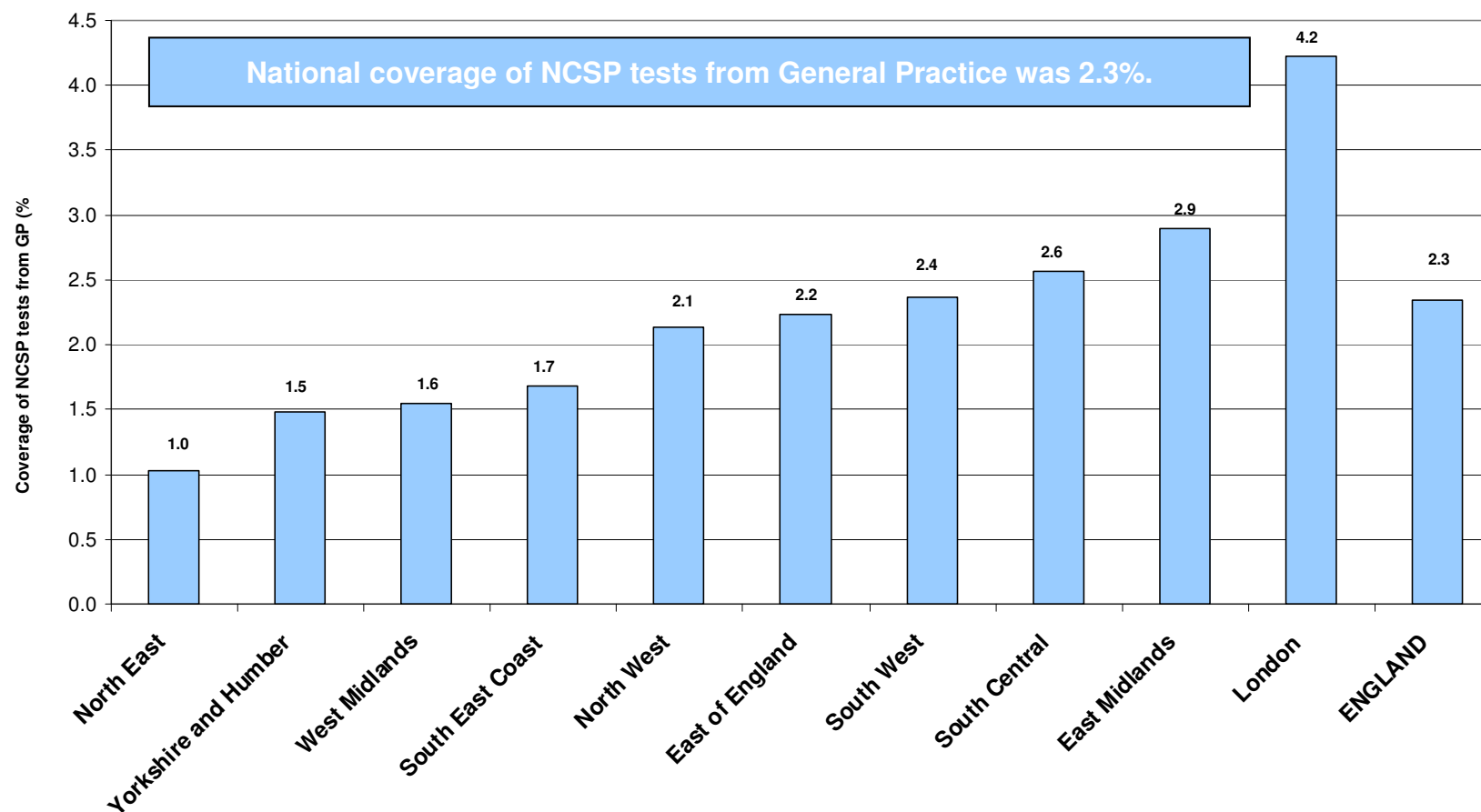

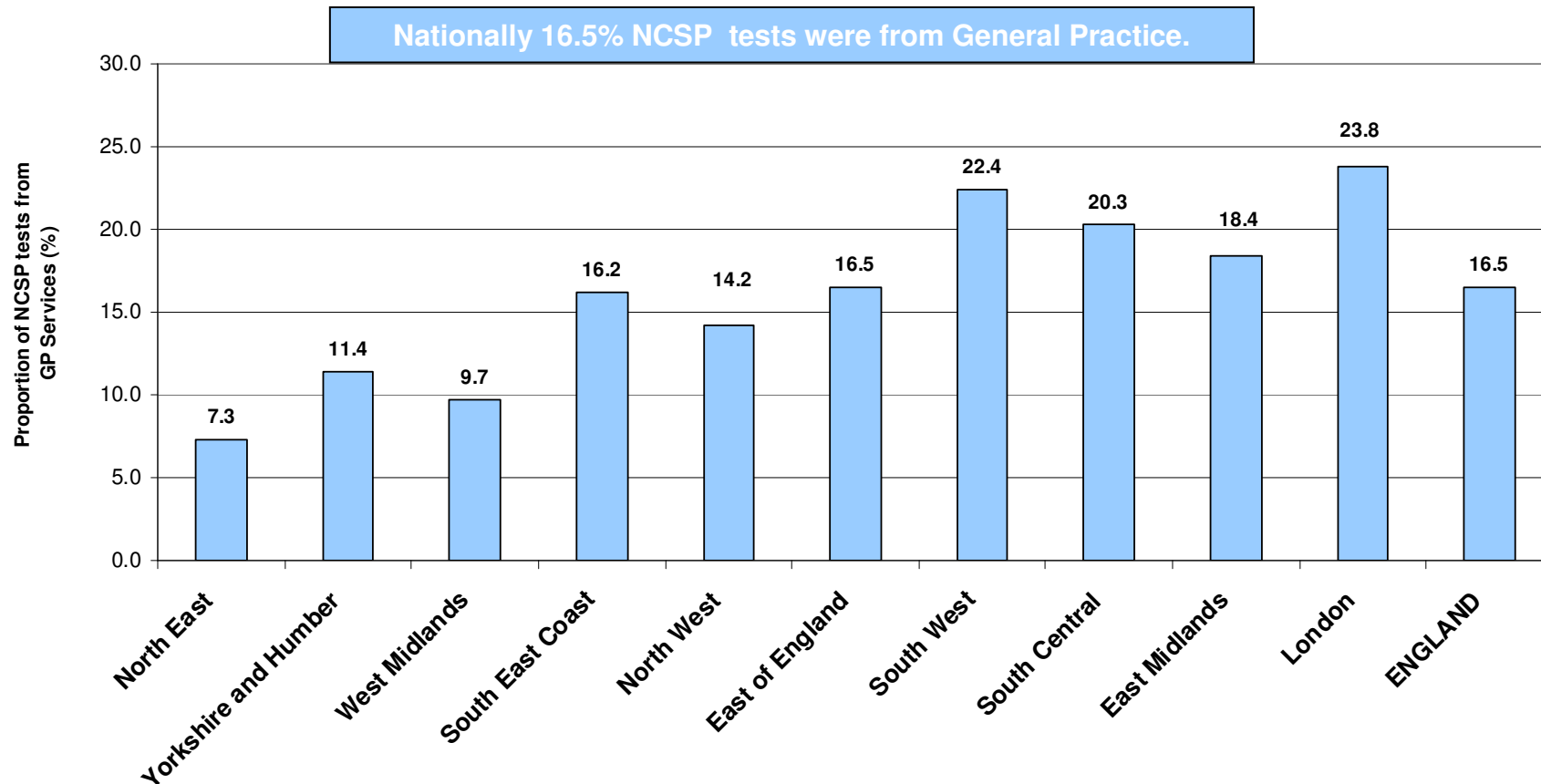
Proportion of tests from Contraception and Sexual Health services: April – December 2010



Coverage of tests from General Practice April – December 2010

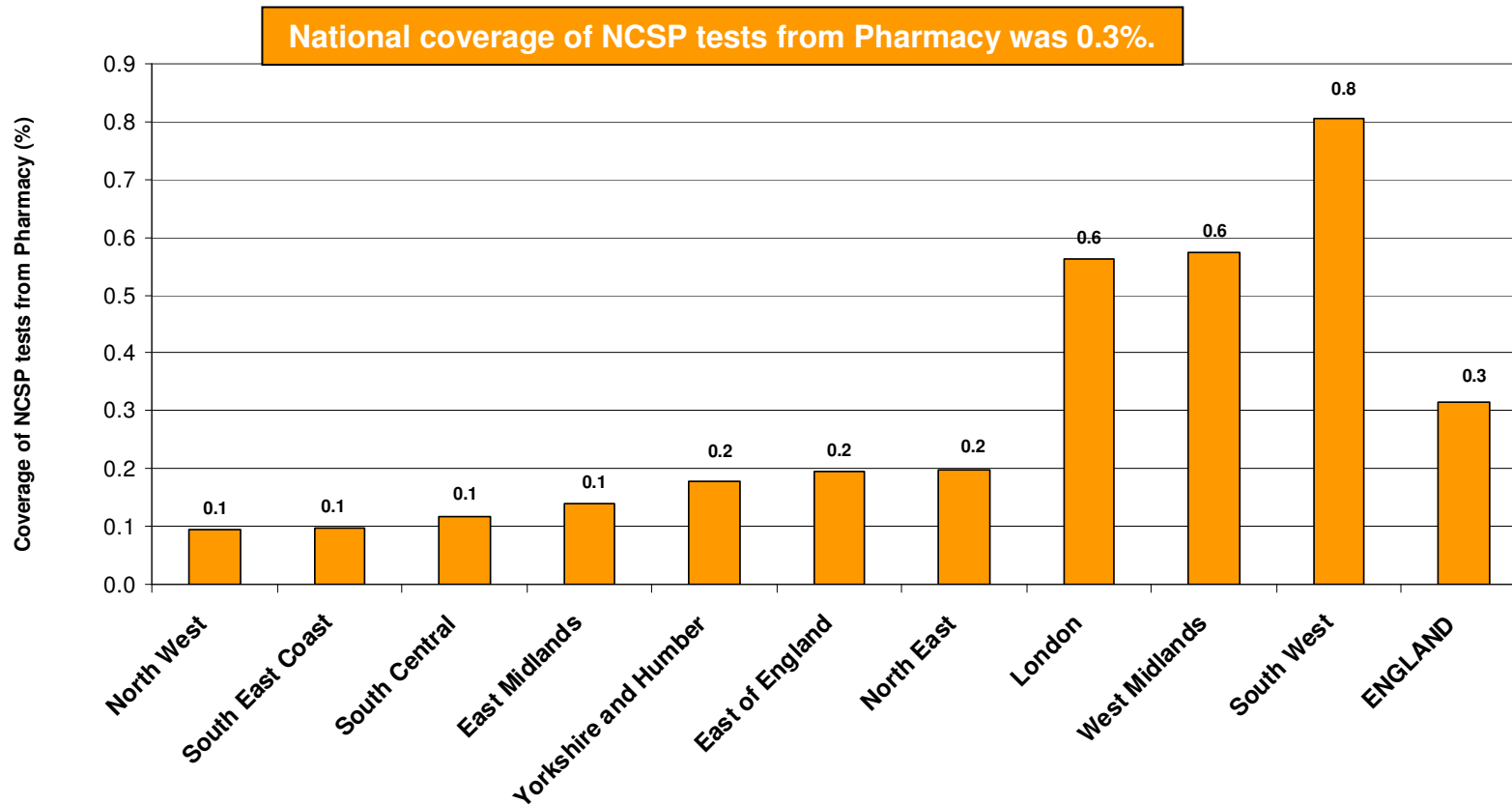

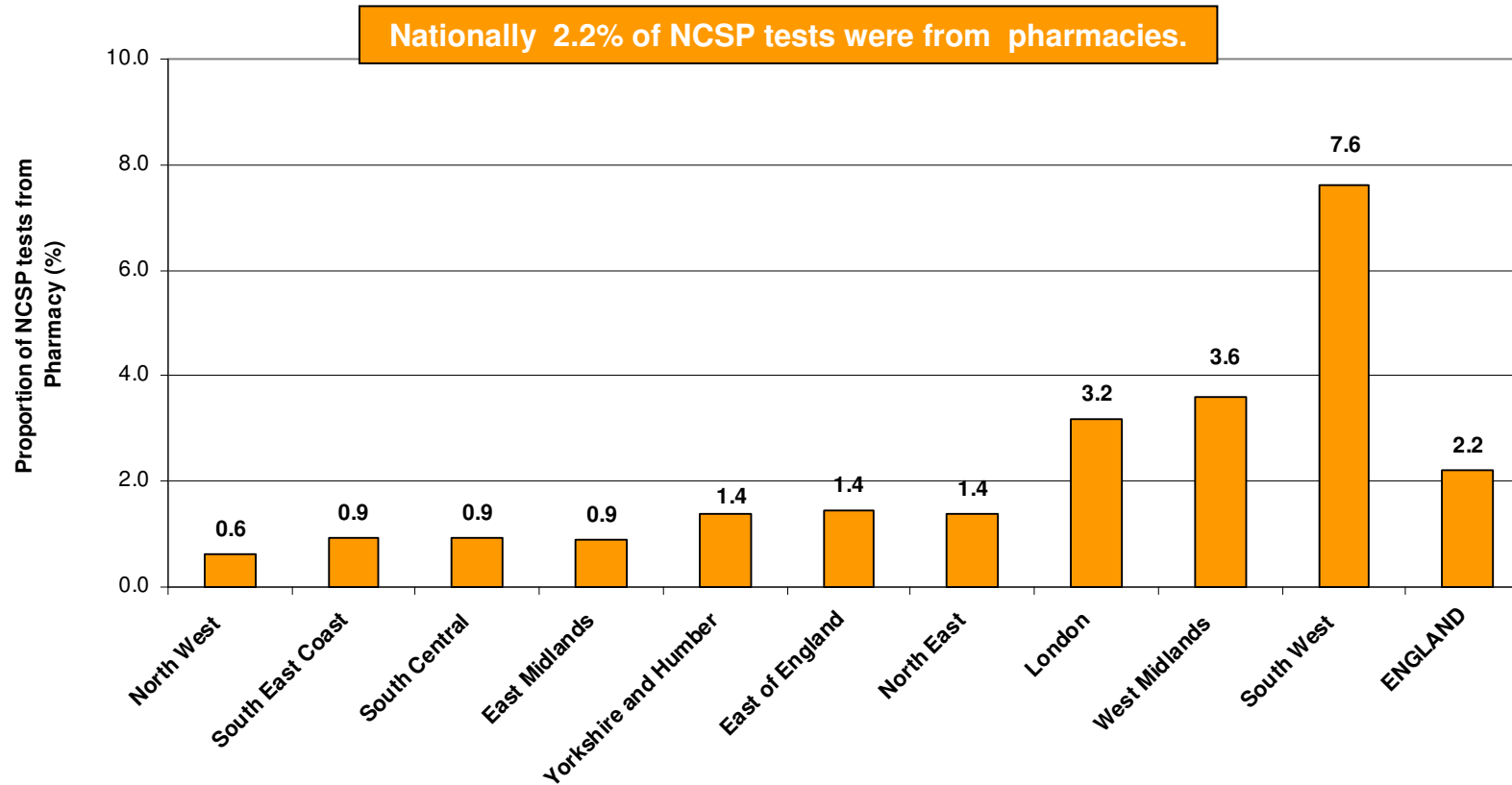

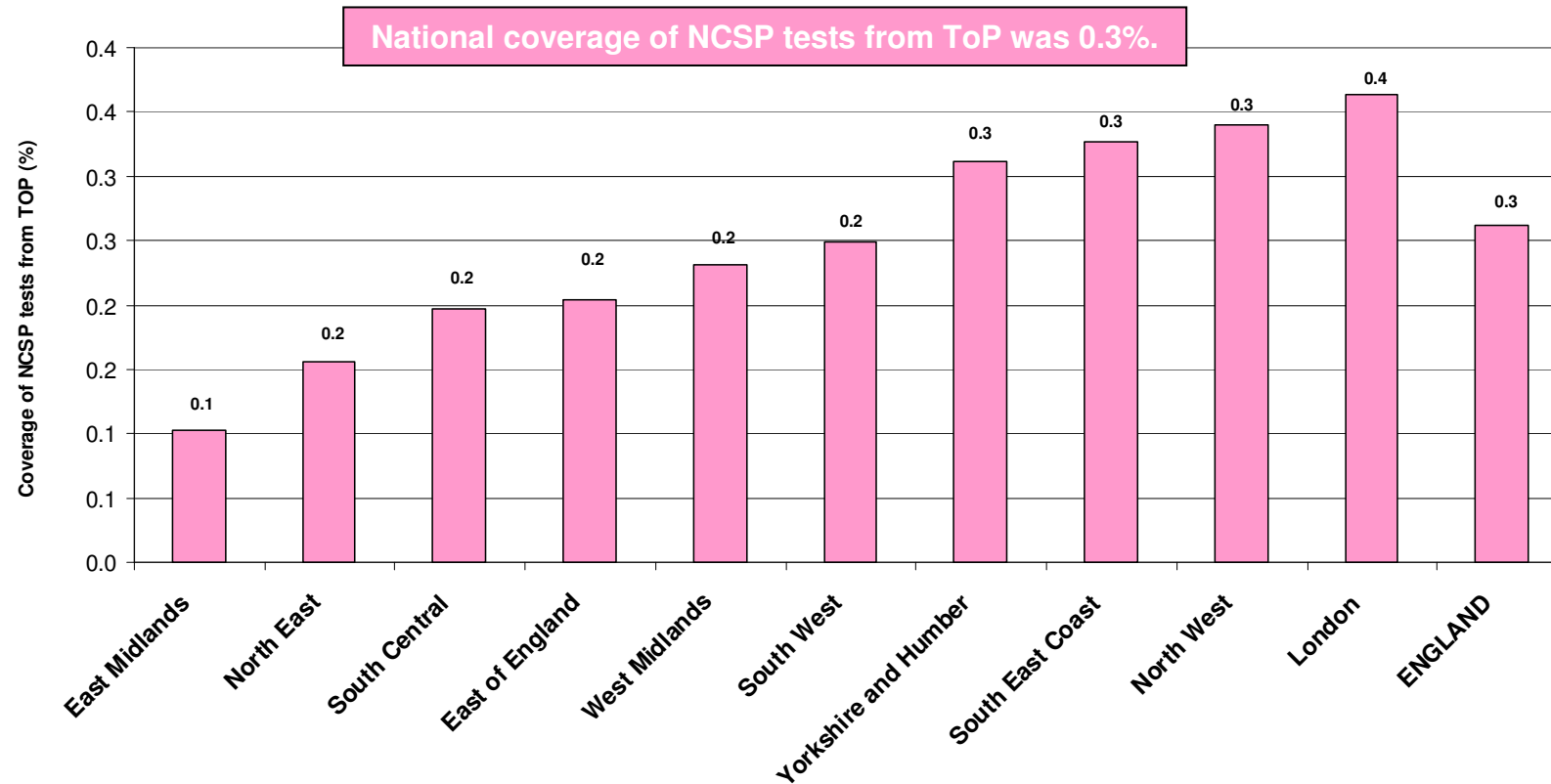

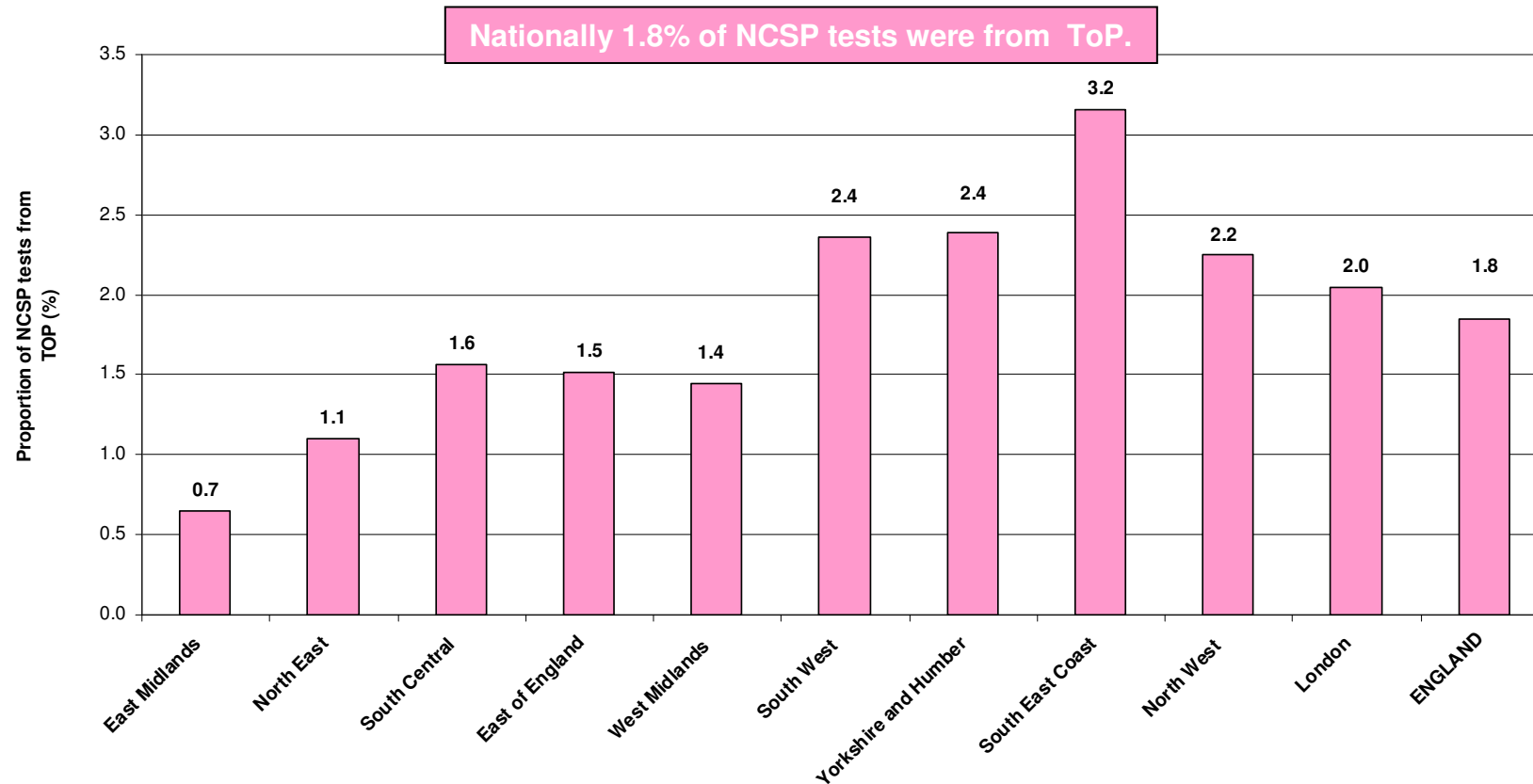
Proportion of tests from Pharmacies: April – December 2010



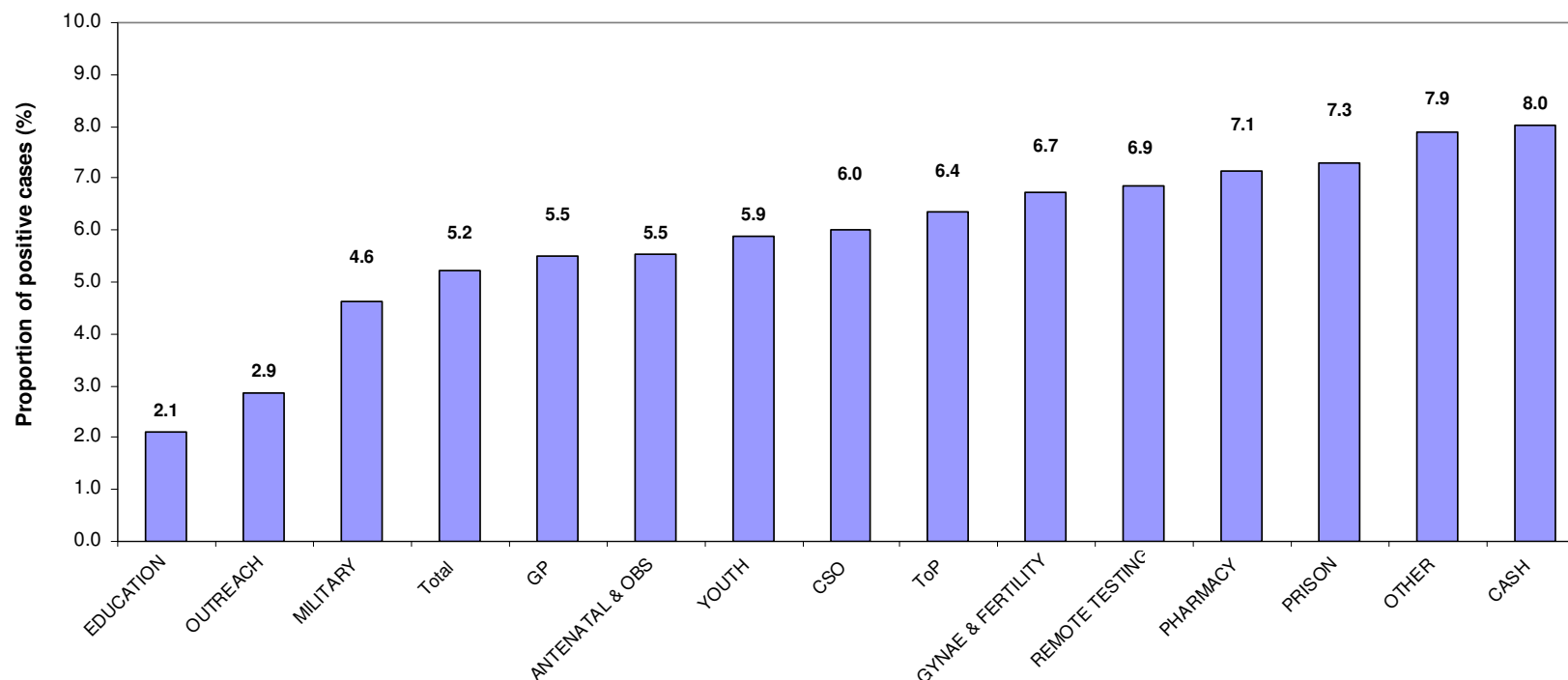
Coverage of tests from Termination of Pregnancy: April - December 2010



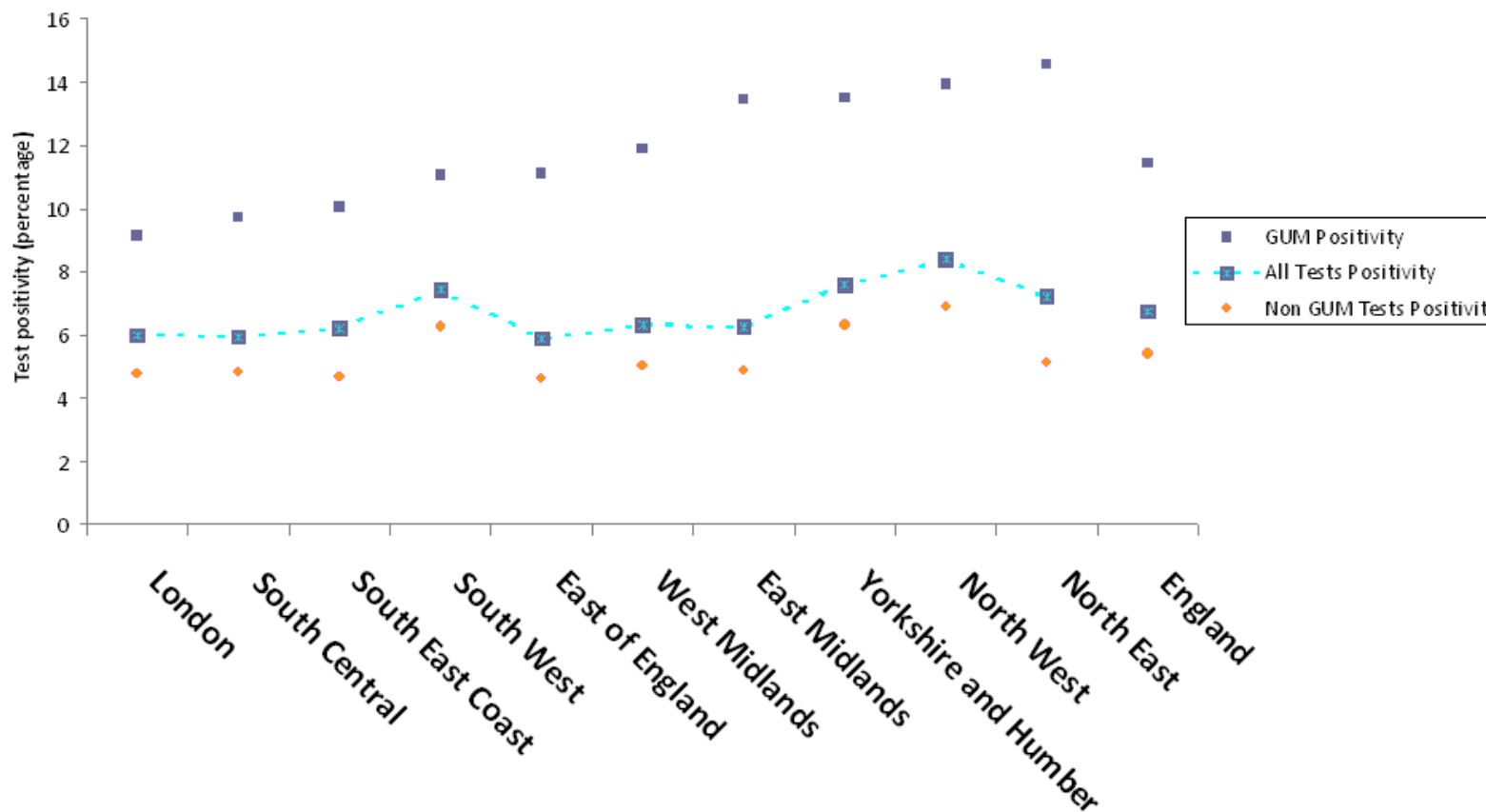
