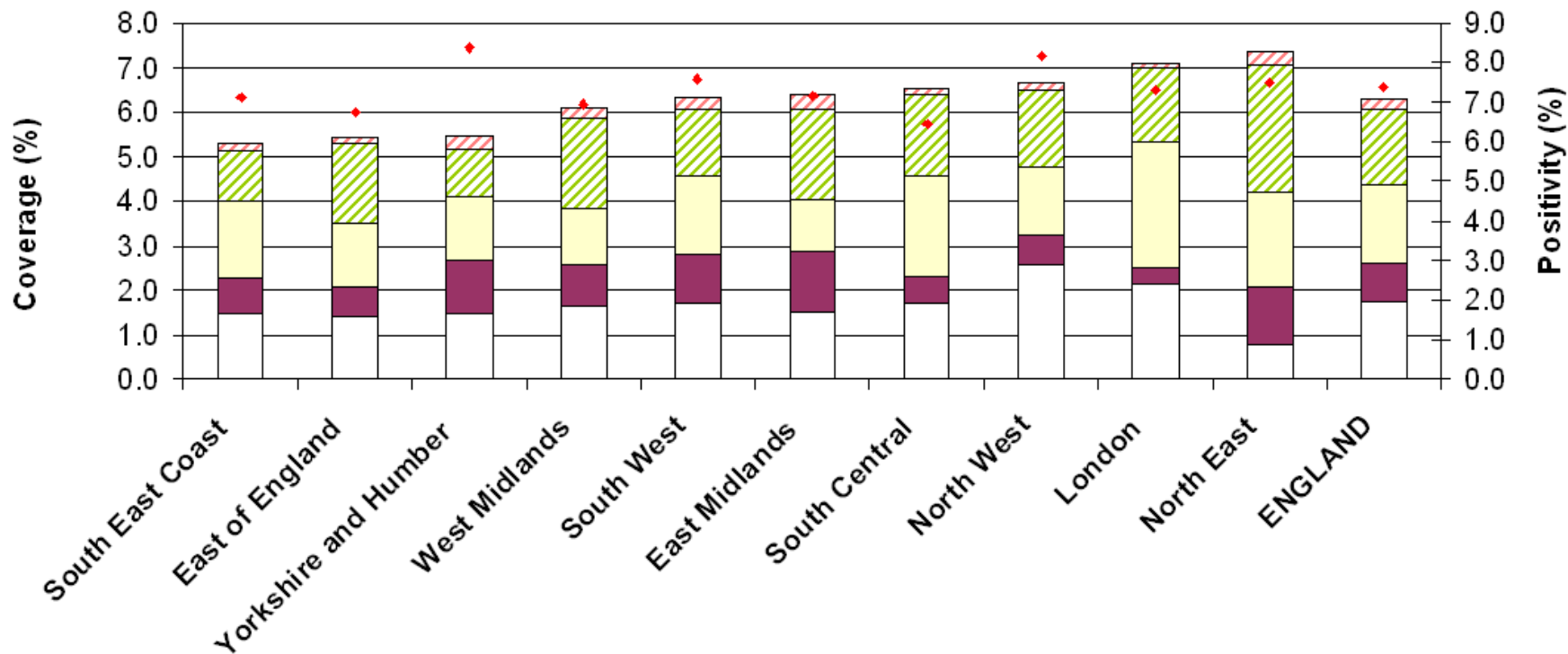

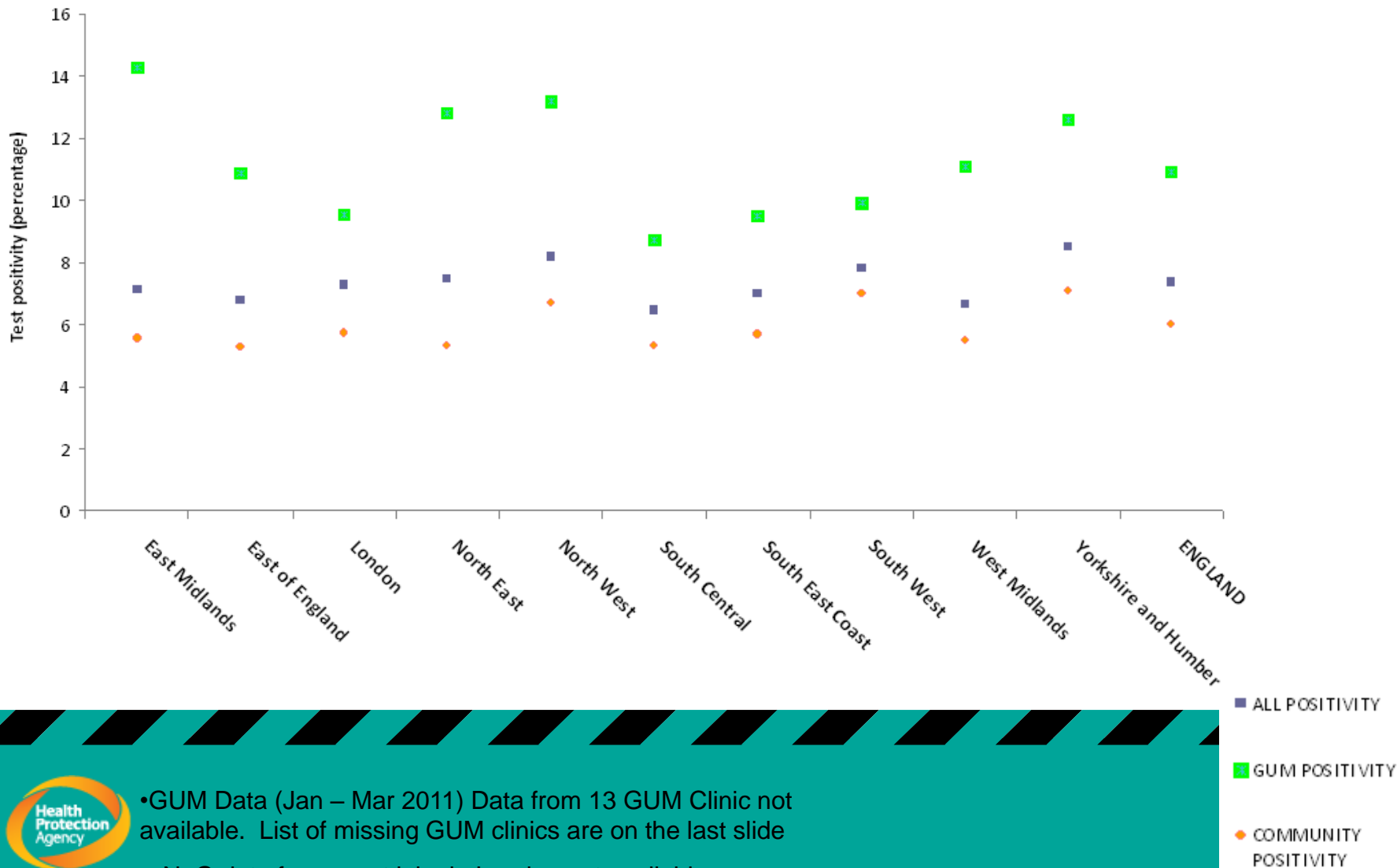

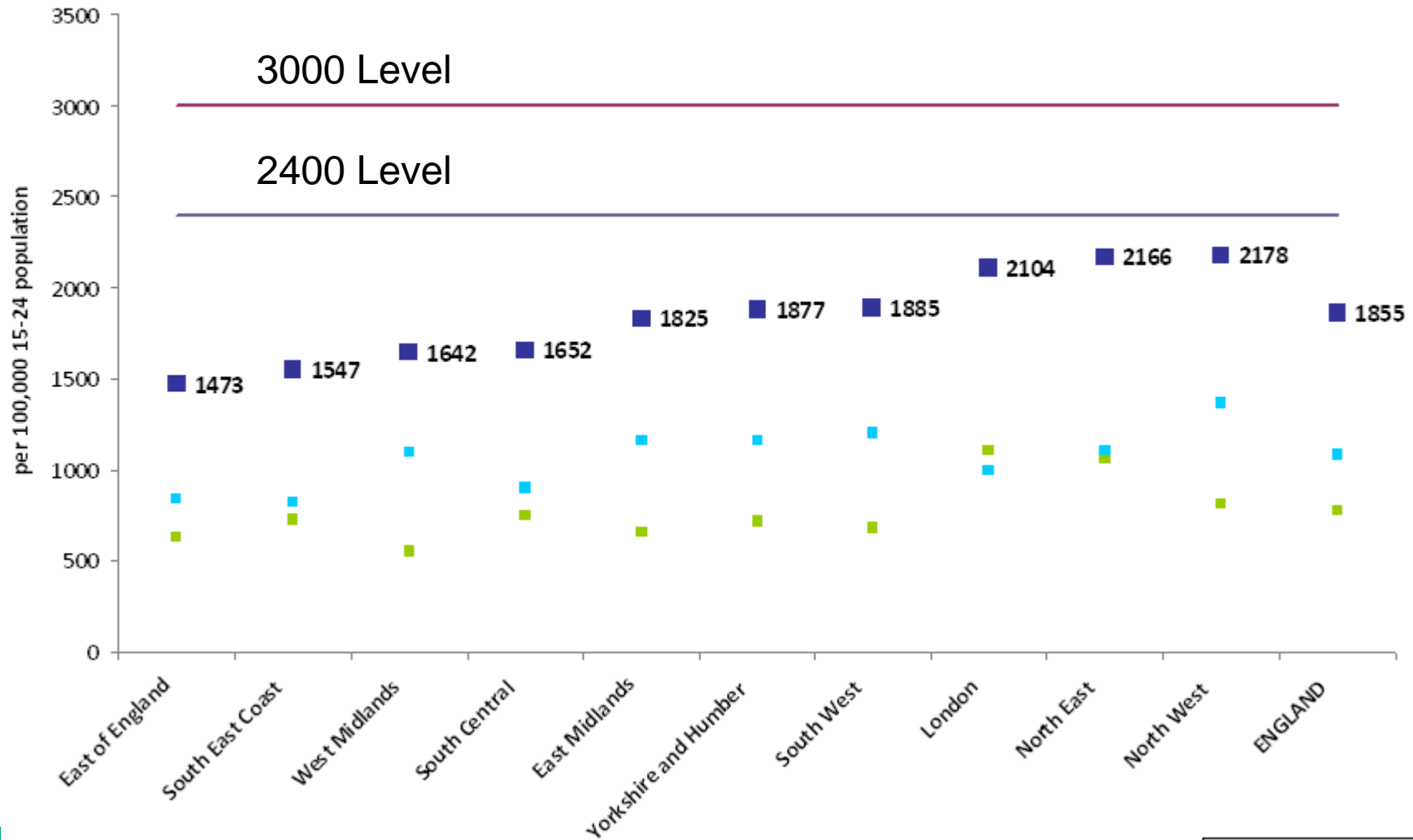

Diagnosis rates per 100,000 15-24 population Q1 2011/12



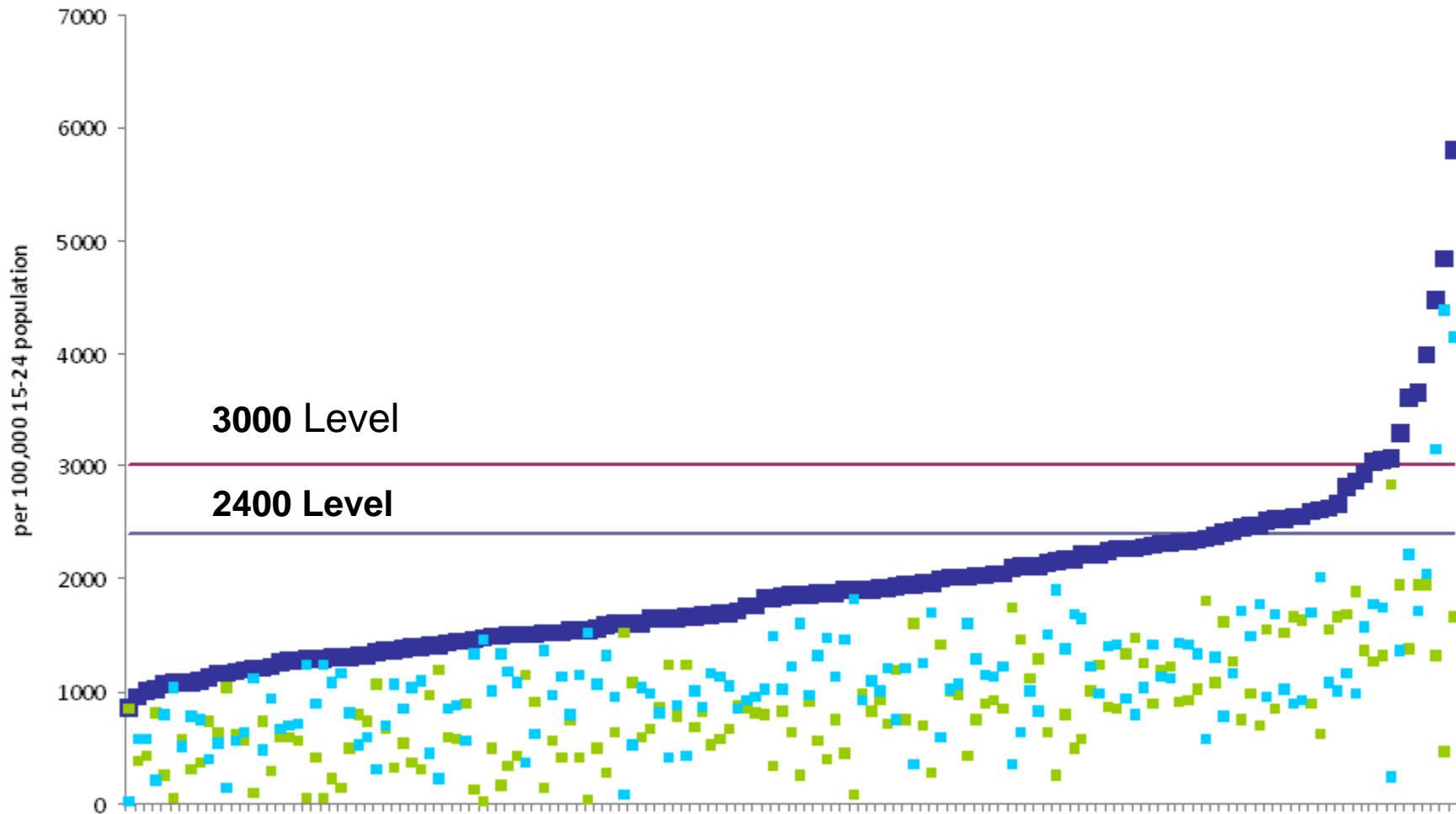

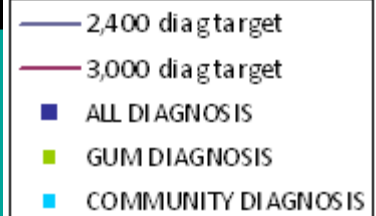

Diagnosis rates per 100,000 15-24 population Q1 2011/12 by PCT



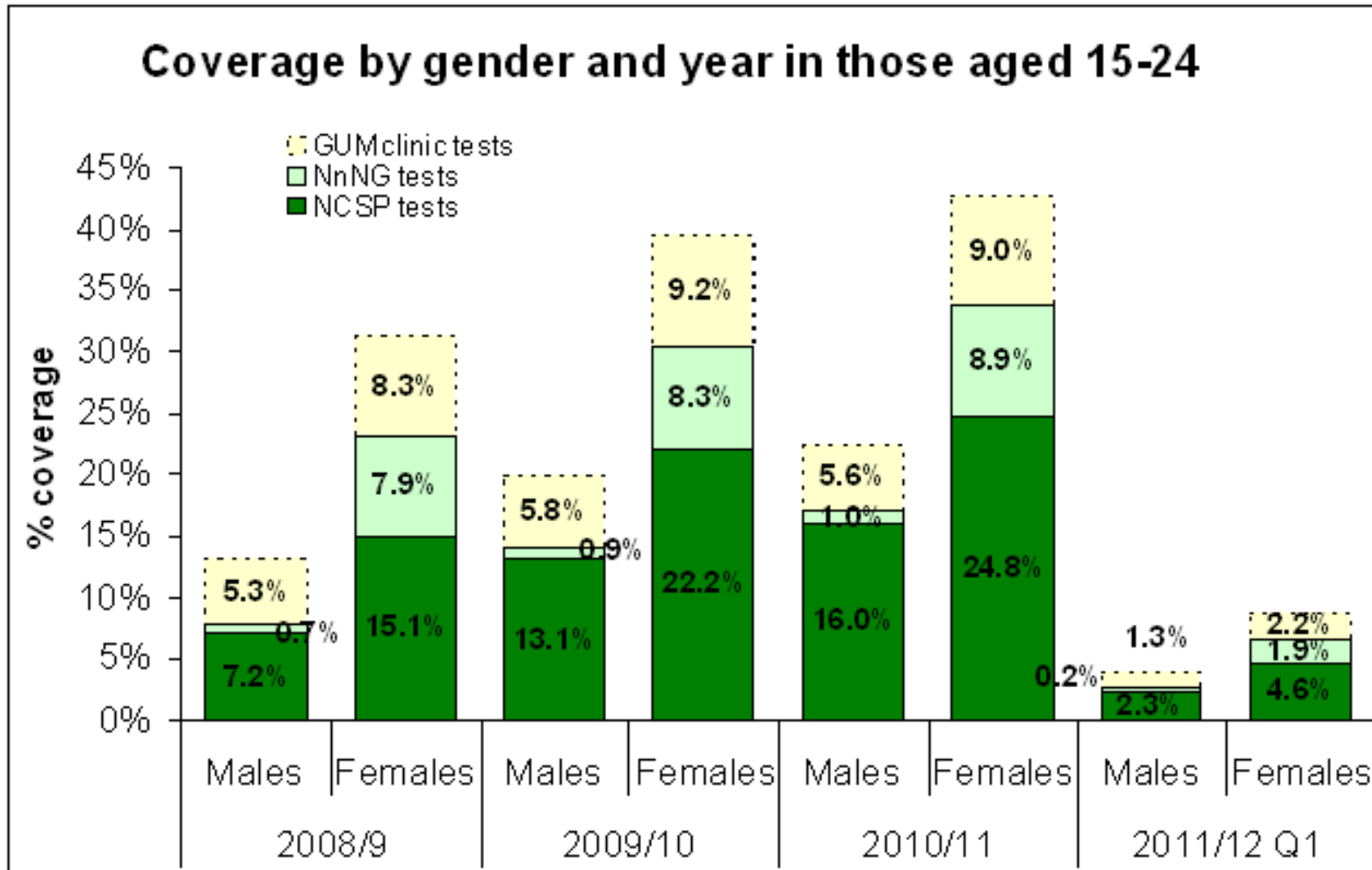

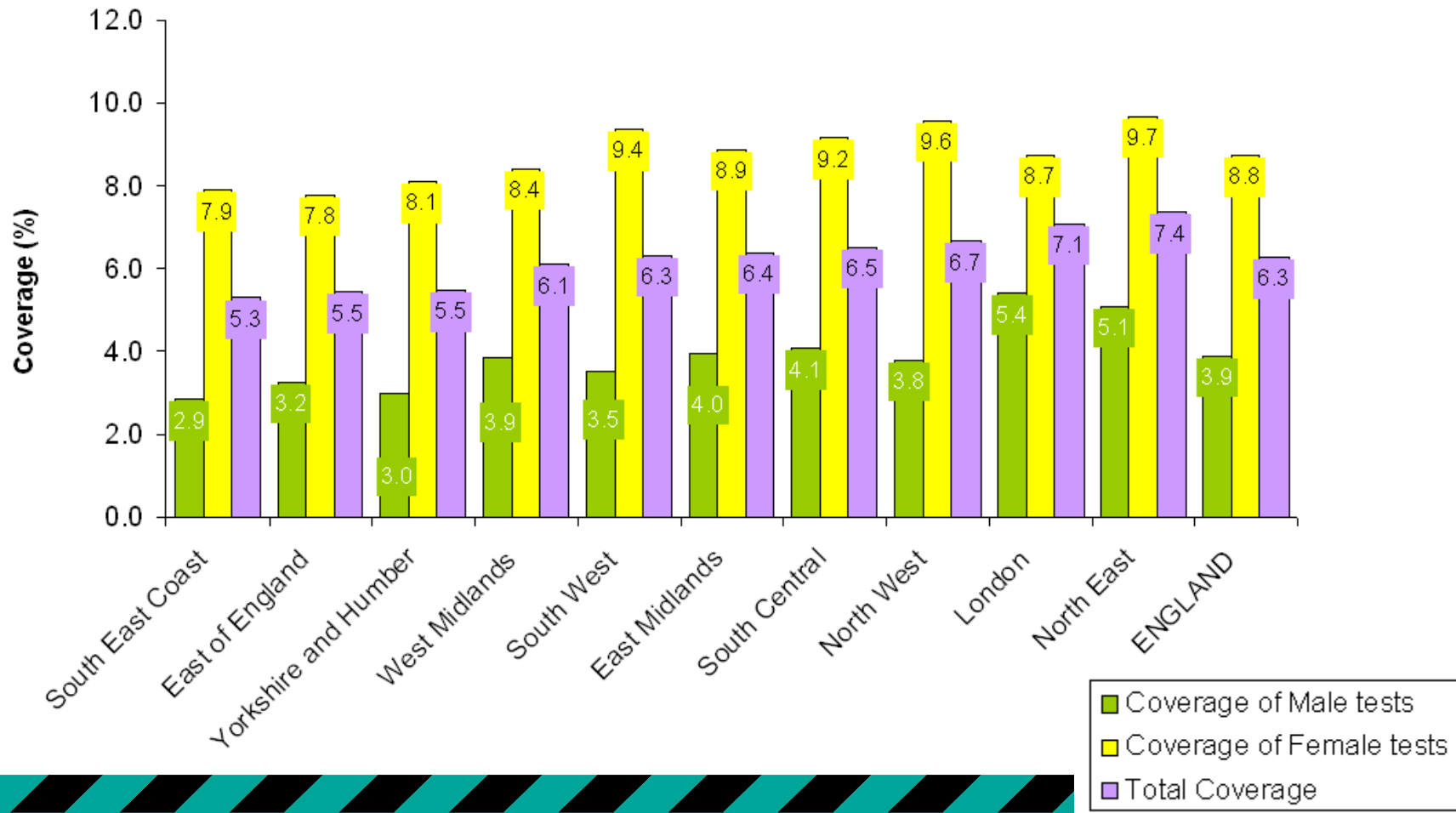

## Coverage by sex including GUM\* April 2011 – June 2011

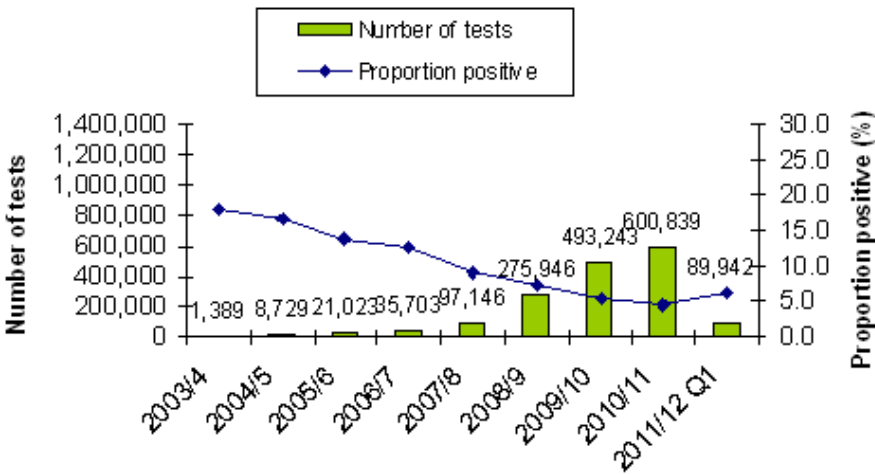

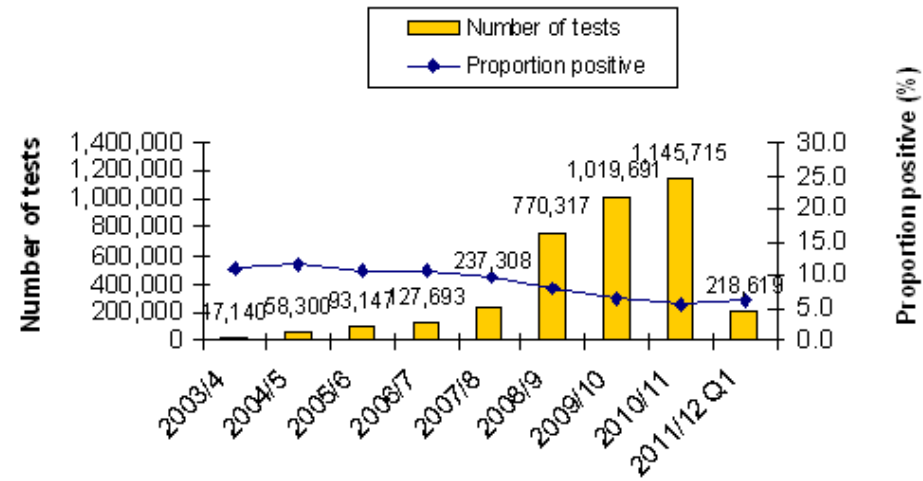

Male



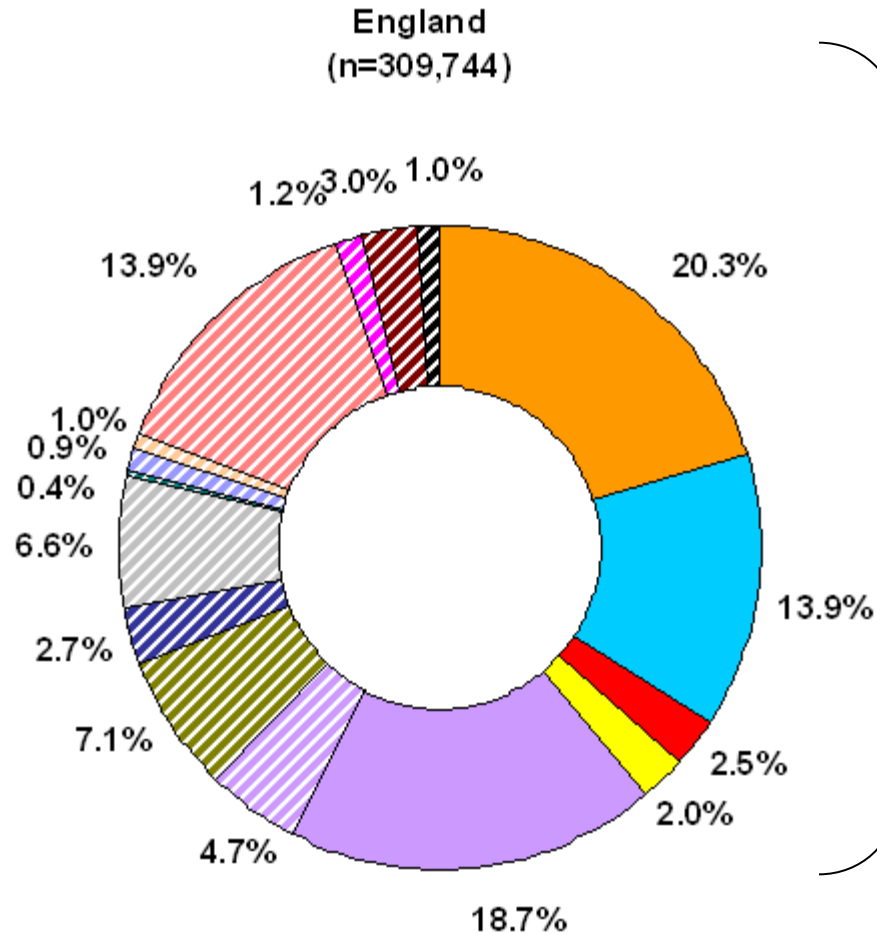

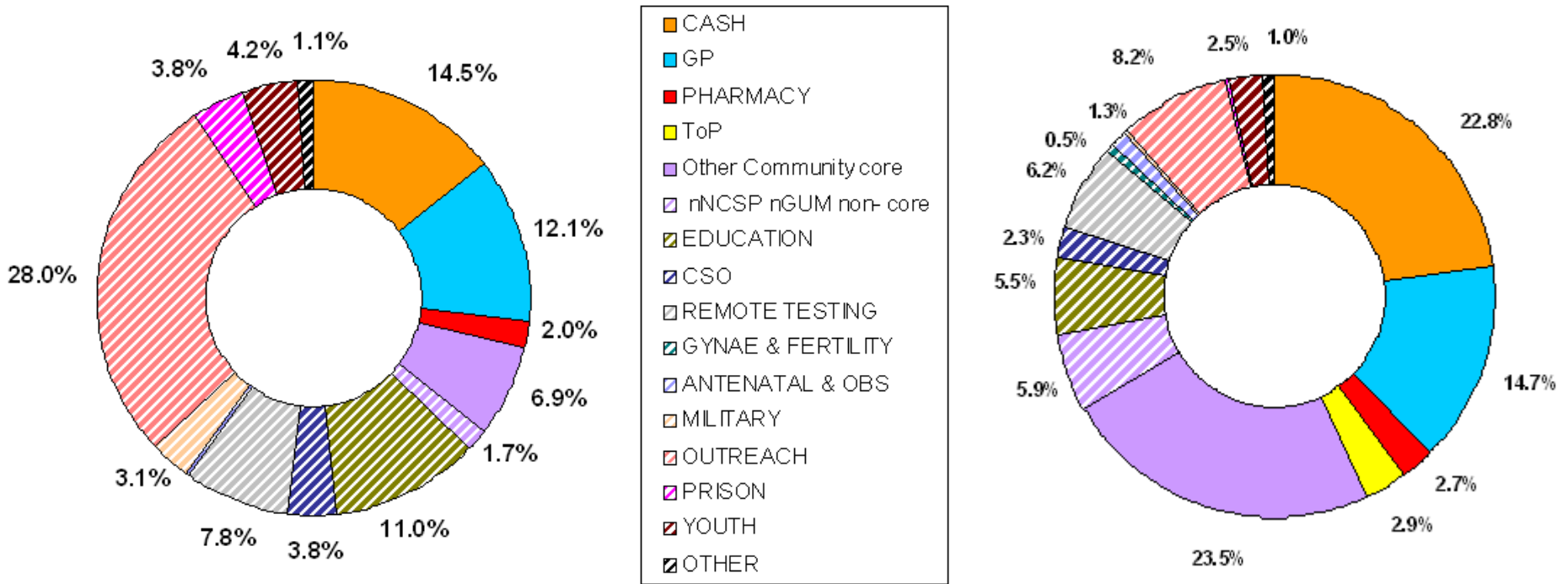

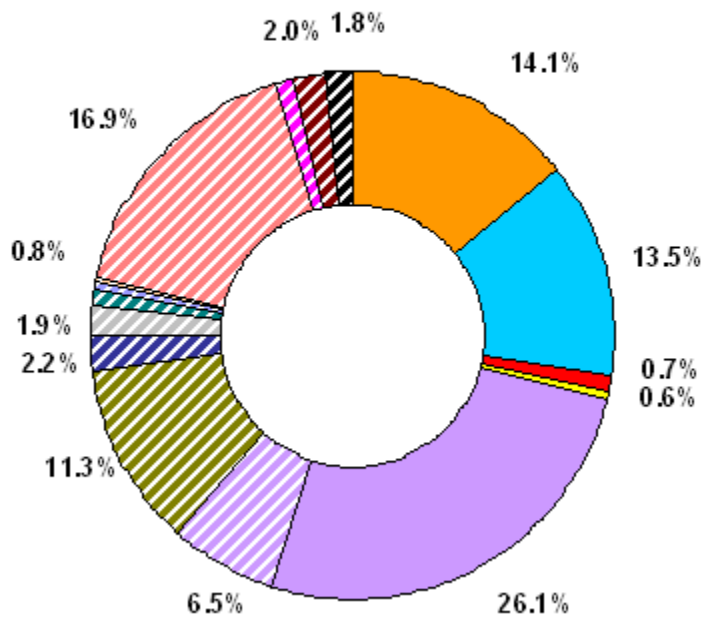

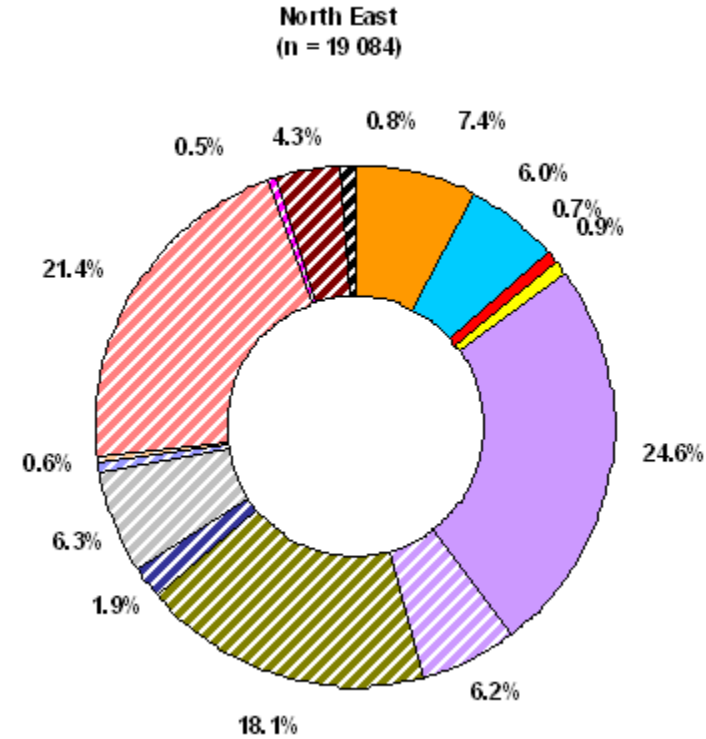

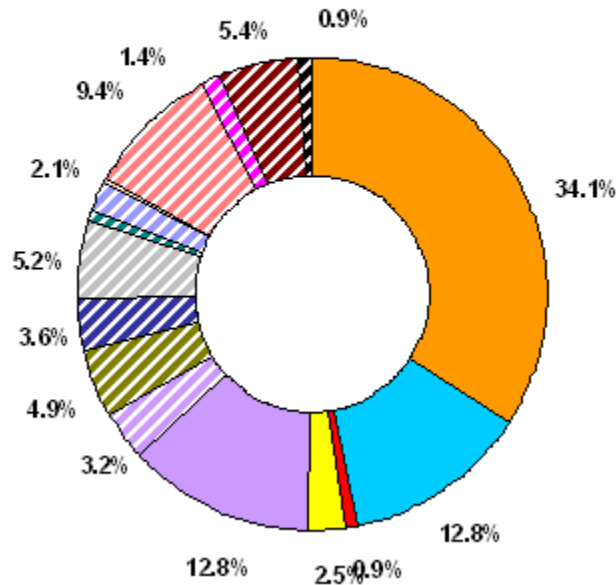

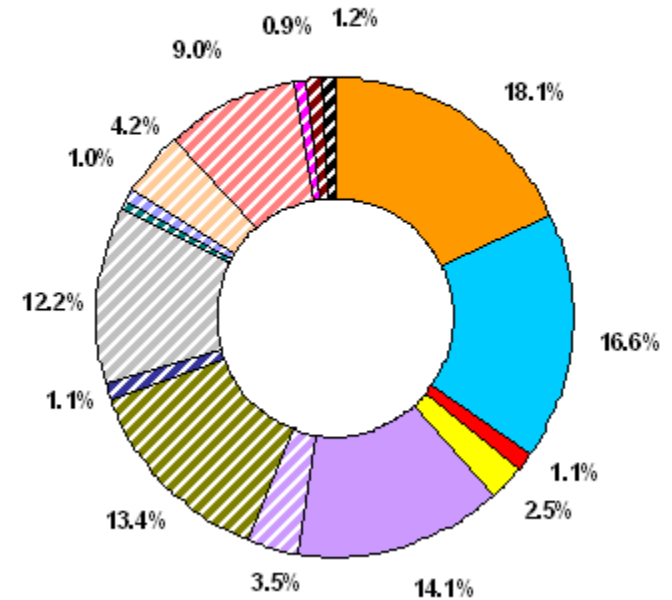

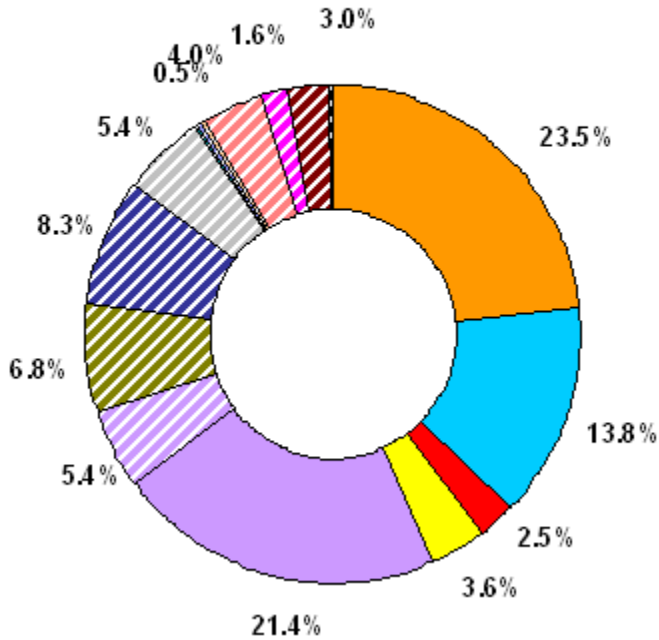

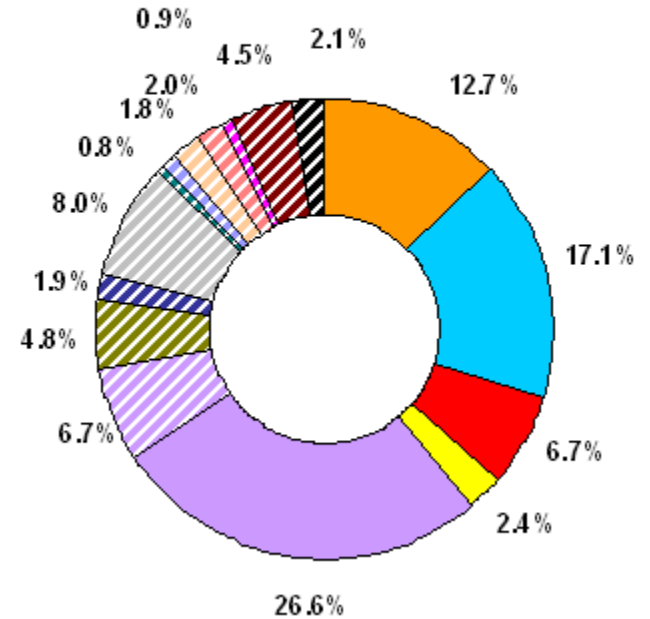

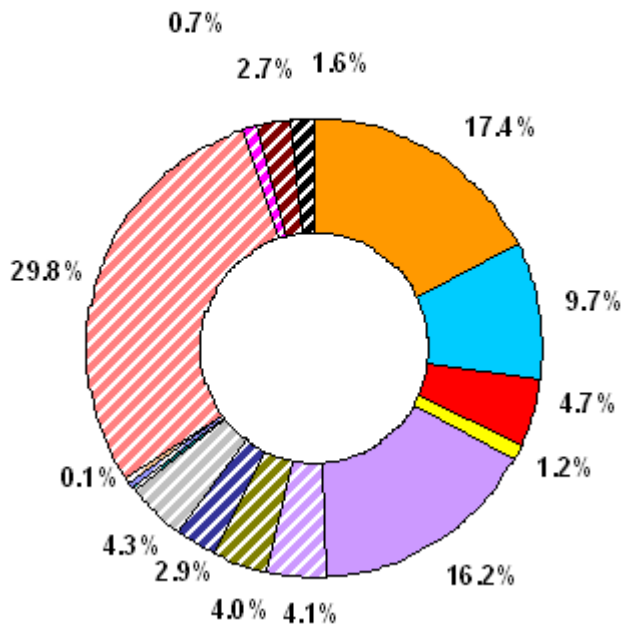

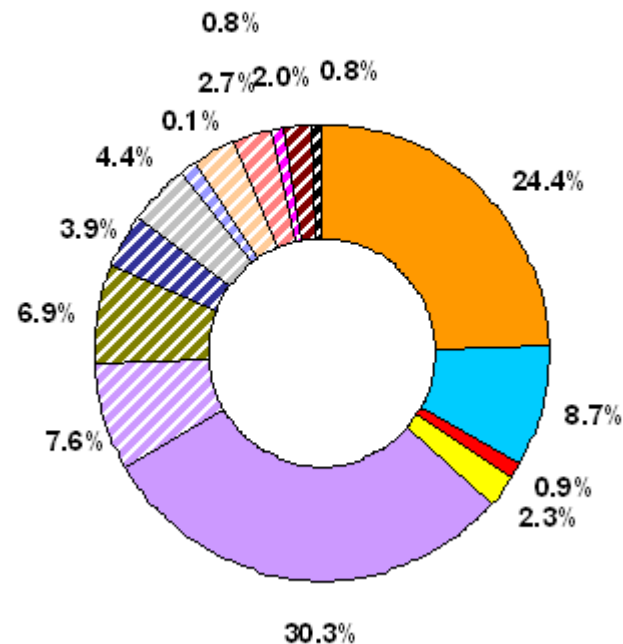

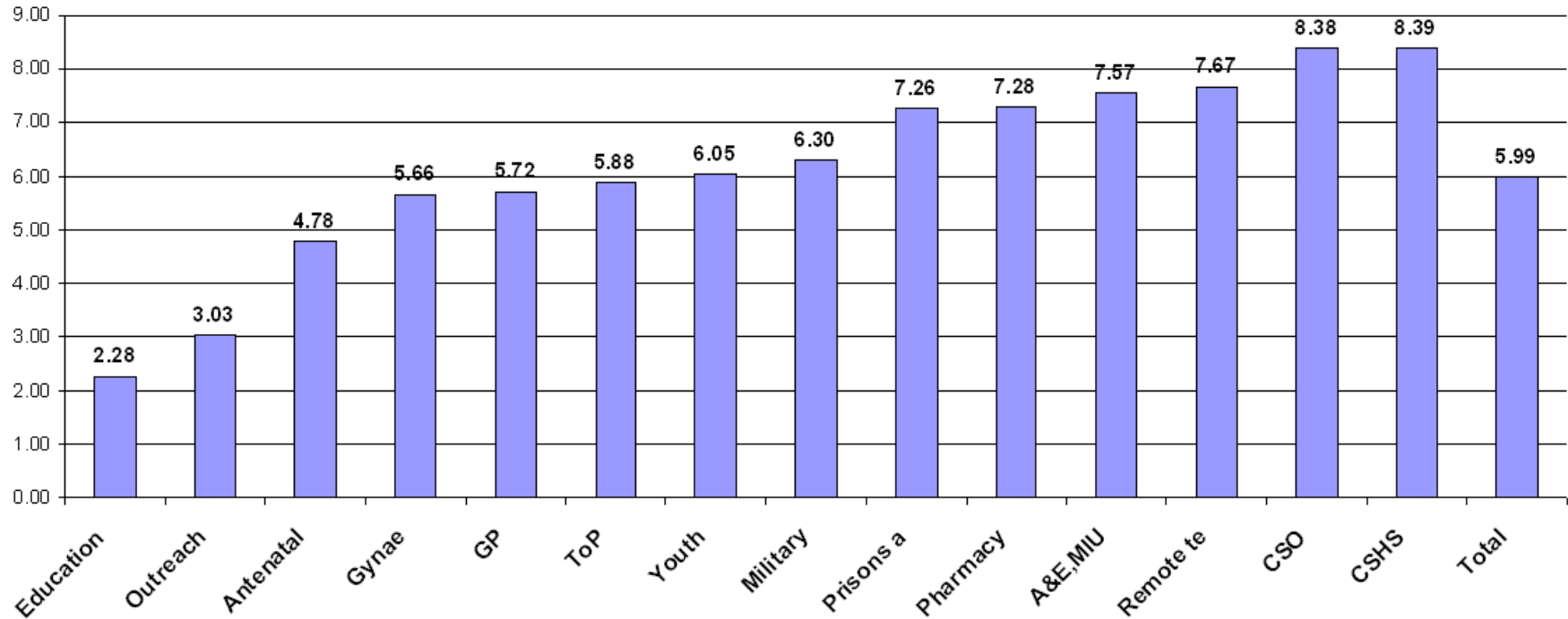

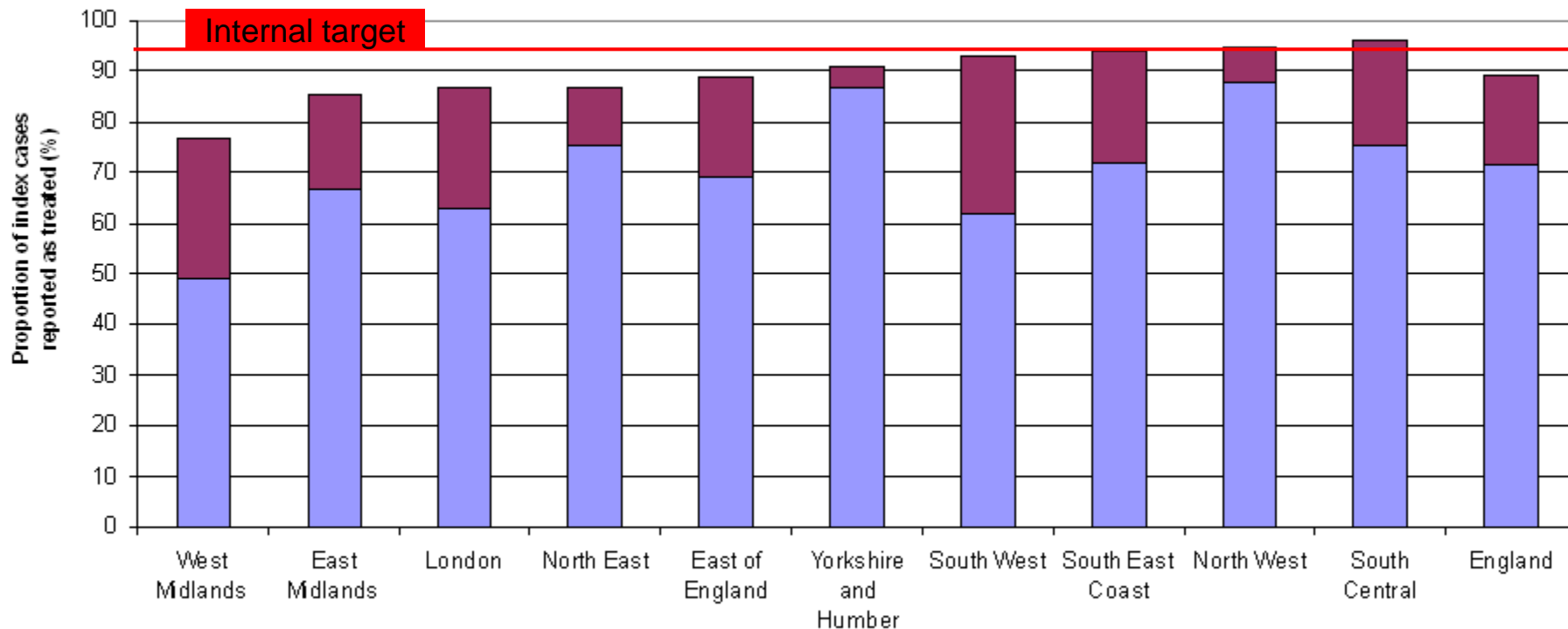
## Proportion of positive cases by venue type: April 2011 – June 2011

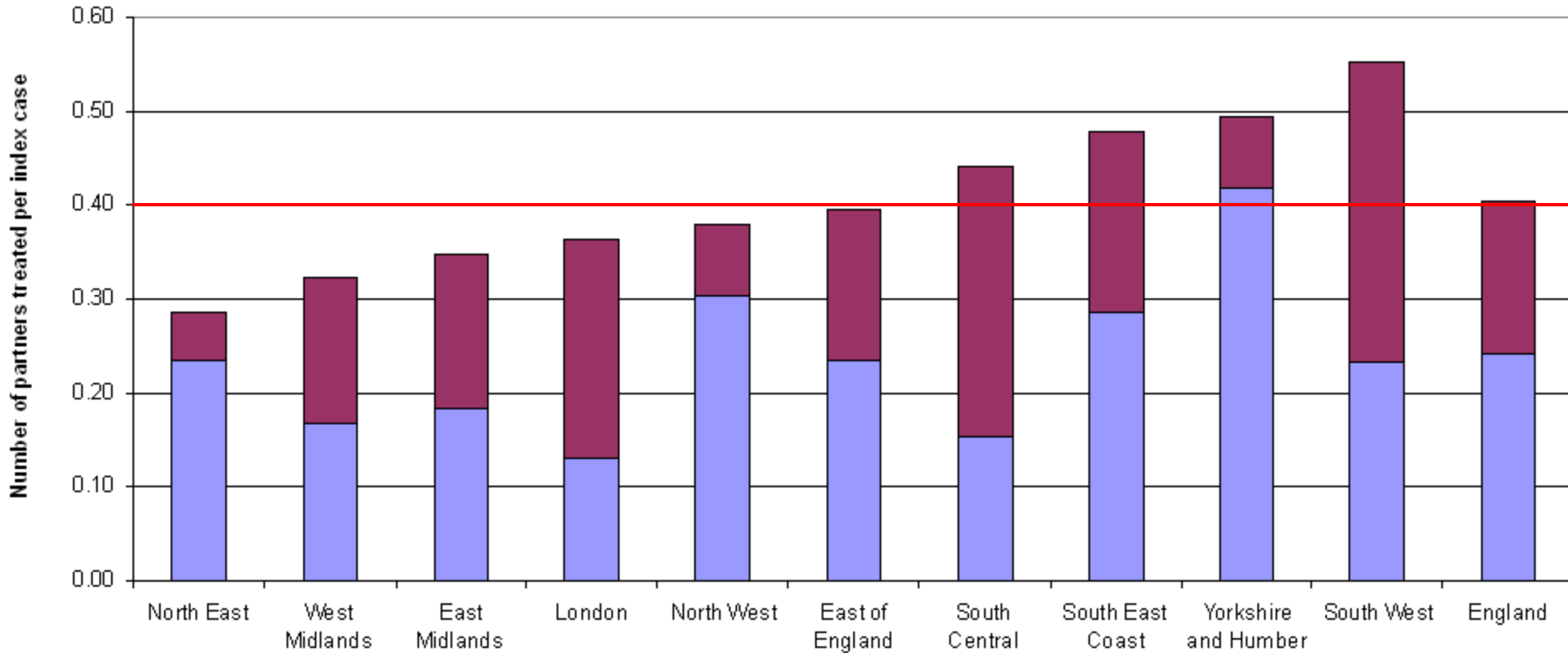
# Proportion of positive index patients reported as treated: England April 2010 – March 2011

Patient Treatment 2010/11



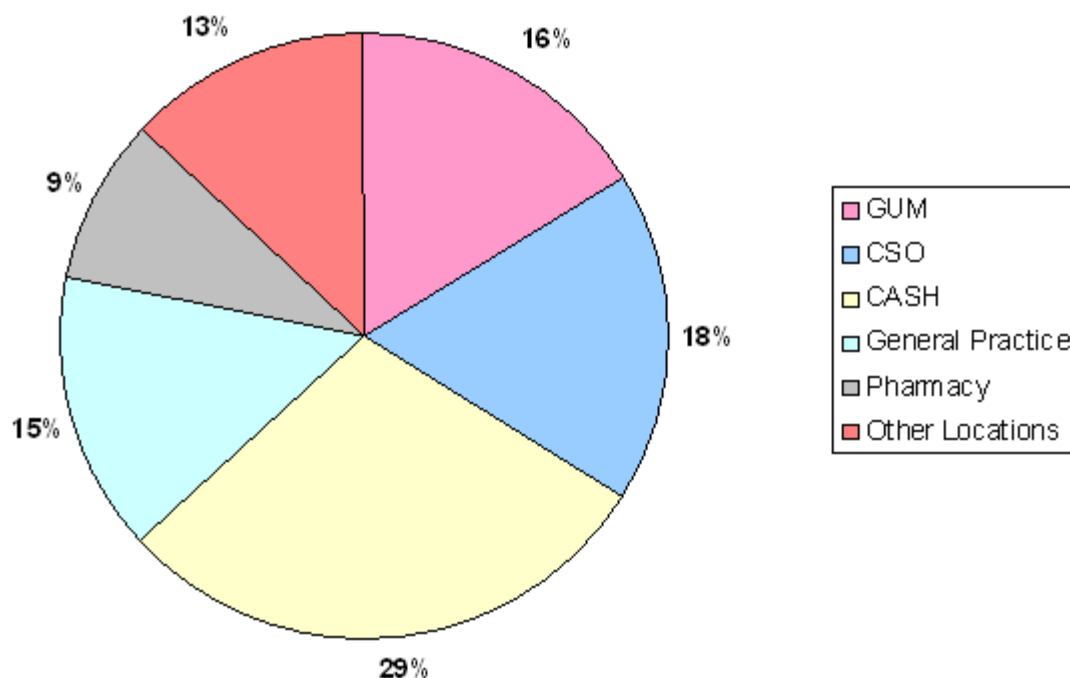
# Number of partners treated per index case: England April 2010 – March 2011

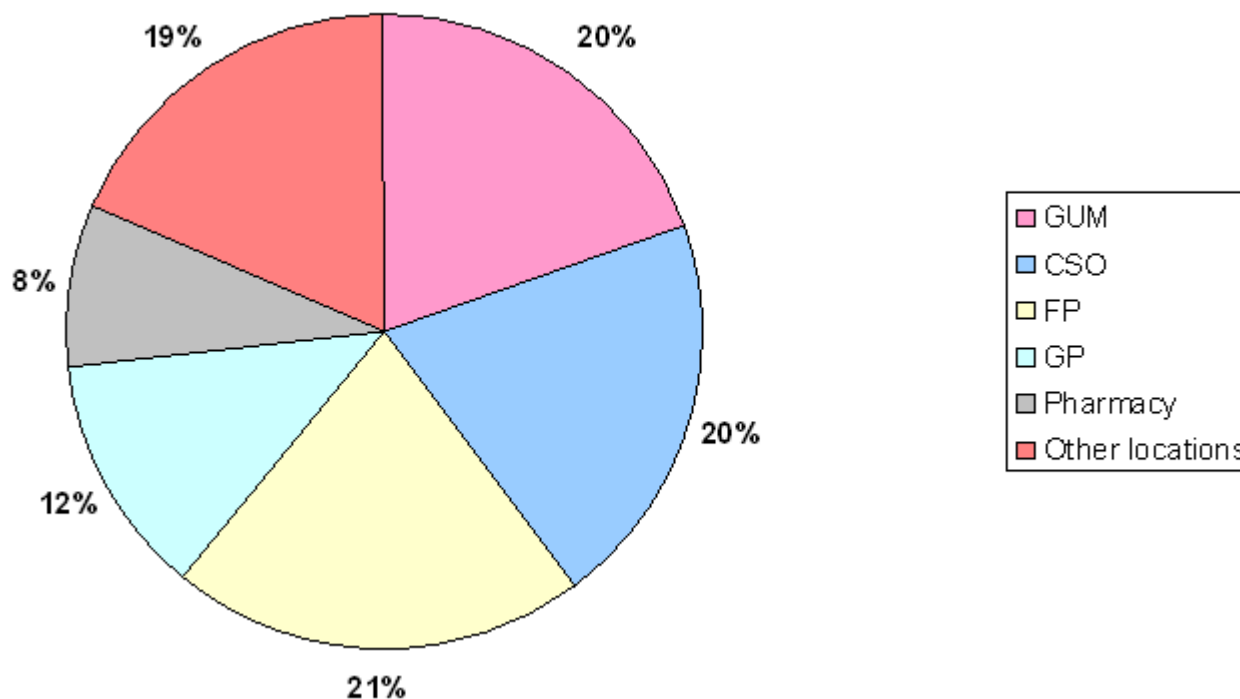
